## **Calls of Interest:**

### **January 11 – 1308 hours Traffic Accident – No Injury**

Officers were dispatched to East South Street to assist Beavercreek Police Department. Our officers stood by while Beavercreek Police Department arrested a female juvenile on a charge of Domestic Violence that occurred in the City of Beavercreek.

### **January 13 – 2030 hours Theft**

An officer was dispatched to an address on Dane Lane regarding a theft. The victim lives in Bellbrook but the theft occurred the victim was in Florida. The case is being handled by Florida authorities and our Detective is assisting them.

### **January 14 – 0110 hours Failure to Comply With A Lawful Order or Signal of A Police Officer**

Greene Central Communications put out information that Kettering Police Department has been involved in a pursuit of an OVI suspect. The pursuit was called off by KPD due to high speeds. Several minutes later, a Bellbrook officer found the vehicle in question on West Franklin Street, near Main Street. The officer attempted to make a traffic stop on the vehicle. The vehicle fled up Little Sugarcreek Road from the officer. The vehicle crashed on Little Sugarcreek Road, at Possum Run Road. The suspect fled on foot. A Greene County Sheriff's Office K-9 was called to the scene to attempt to track the suspect with negative results. The next day, the suspect was identified and taken into custody by his probation officer. The Detective went to the Montgomery County Jail where the suspect was being incarcerated and issued a misdemeanor citation. For the record, the suspect is being charged with felony charges from Kettering Police Department.
