## **Calls of Interest:**

### **April 27 – 1934 hours Criminal Damaging**

An officer was dispatched to a business on South East Street. A key box was damaged and was witnessed by other people. A juvenile was charged with criminal damaging.

### **April 28 – 1923 hours Assist Other Agency**
