Calls of Interest:

May 3 – 0308 hours Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication

May 7 – 0800 hours Traffic Accident – No Injury

A passenger in the vehicle was also charged with Drug Possession and Drug Paraphernalia. Both subjects were cited into Greene County Juvenile Court and released to their parents.
