## **October 11 – 0029 hours**

A traffic stop for a moving violation on West Franklin Street led to the arrest of the driver for OVI. The suspect was cited into XMC and released to a relative.

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Rd for expired registration. Investigation revealed that the driver had a suspended driver's license. He was cited into XMC.

## **October 11 – 1312 hours**

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road. A motorcycle traveling south on Wilmington-Dayton Road did not notice a stopped vehicle and struck it as a result. The motorcycle rider was taken to the hospital for non-life threatening injuries.

## **October 11 – 1922 hours**

An officer was dispatched to South Lakeman Drive on a criminal damaging report. The complainant advised that her vehicle had been "keyed" while it was parked in her driveway. Investigation revealed who was responsible for the damage, but the vehicle owner did not want to pursue criminal charges.

## **October 17 – 1228 hours**

An accident with injuries was reported on W Franklin Street. A vehicle traveling struck another vehicle that was stopped in traffic. The driver at fault was cited into XMC.
