## **October 21, 2015 – 1634 hours**

The Bellbrook Service Department requested an officer to respond to Regent Park Drive for a tree in the roadway, causing a traffic hazard. The officer made contact with a tree removal company and were warned that they could not drop a tree in the roadway. Further investigation revealed that one of the employees was wanted on an active warrant from Warren County S.O. A second officer was dispatched, who upon his arrival took the subject into custody. The wanted subject was transported to Waynesville, where custody was turned over to a Warren County Sheriff's deputy. The officer on Regent Park Drive remained on scene to control traffic until the tree was removed from the roadway.

## **October 21, 2015 – 1905 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment and registration violation. It was learned that the driver of the vehicle had a suspended driver's license. He was cited into XMC for Driving Under Suspension and Display of Registration Required. Further investigation revealed that a passenger in the vehicle was wanted on an active warrant from Clark County S.O. The subject was transported to the Greene County Jail.

## **October 23, 2015 – 0405 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer found a vehicle trunk open on Bellemeade Drive. Attempted contact with the homeowner was unsuccessful. The officer re-secured the trunk.

A resident on W Franklin Street reported fraudulent charges on her credit card. The report is under investigation.
