October 25, 2015 – 0025 hours

Officers responded to Eckworth Drive on the report of a loud party. Officers had been at the same address twice a few hours earlier for the same complaint. Officers spoke to the homeowner who was ordered to end the party.

October 25, 2015 – 1437 hours

Officers were dispatched to an address on Upper Bellbrook Road for a fight in progress. Upon the officers' arrival the fight was already over. None of the involved parties cooperated with officers or requested to file charges.

October 26, 2015 – 1124 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on S Belleview Drive. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. No charges filed.
