A traffic stop on West Franklin Street for a Defective Muffler led to the arrest of the 41-year old driver from Middletown for Driving with a Suspended Drivers' License.

November 9, 2015 – 0630 hours

An officer assisted Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a traffic accident on Wilmington Pike near State Route 725.
