December 27, 2015 – 0114 hours

A traffic stop on South Linda Drive led to the arrest of the driver for Driving Under Suspension. The 33-year old suspect from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.

December 27, 2015 – 0249 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer observed a female staggering across a parking lot at a business on State Route 725. The officer made contact with the female for her safety. She was found to be highly intoxicated. A relative was called to give her a ride home.

December 27, 2015 – 1356 hours

Officers were dispatched to Locus Bend Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. Investigation revealed that strong winds had blown open a back door. The residence was re-secured.

December 27, 2015 – 2227 hours

A traffic stop for a moving violation on Wilmington-Dayton Road led to the arrest of the 46-year old driver from Waynesville for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Signal and OVI and then released to a relative.

While on routine patrol an officer located three males standing around a vehicle on Sable Ridge Drive. Upon investigation, the officer detected a strong odor of alcohol on one of the subjects, who was a 20-year old Xenia resident. An officer was dispatched to Belair Circle on the report of Loud Music. Contact was made with the homeowner who apologized and turned off the music.

During the investigation, officers made contact with the subject's girlfriend who gave false identity information to officers, claiming to be a 32-year old female. Further investigation revealed that the female had used her daughter's identification, and was actually 58 years old and wanted on a warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. She was charged with Falsification and Obstructing Official Business, and transported to the Greene County Jail.
