April 24, 2016 – 0320 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Walnut Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 26-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Driving on a Closed Road.

April 24, 2016 – 1836 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle pulling a trailer without a license plate. The 38-year old driver from Middletown did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

April 24, 2016 – 2133 hours

An officer was dispatched to McGee Park on the report of persons in the park after hours. The officers located 5 subjects and advised them that the park was closed. The subjects left the area without problem.

April 25, 2016 – 1837 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 29-year old driver from Springfield was wanted on an active warrant from the Clark County Sheriff's Department. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

April 25, 2016 – 2210 hours

A vehicle attempting to make a U-turn on South Lakeman Drive drove into oncoming traffic and struck a vehicle head on. The 19-year old driver from Fairborn was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.



April 26, 2016 - 0804 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street on the report of two juveniles attempting to buy cigarettes. Officers spoke to the juveniles and warned them about their actions.

April 26, 2016 – 1700 hours

While on routine patrol an officer observed a disabled vehicle at the intersection of Wilmington-Dayton Road and Bellemeade Drive. The officer was able to push the vehicle off the roadway and stood by until it was removed by a tow truck.

April 26, 2016 - 1750 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after a routine vehicle registration check revealed that the vehicle had fictitious license plates on it that were also expired. The 40-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Fictitious Registration, and Expired Registration.

April 28, 2016 – 1157 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure. Confirmed false alarm.

April 29, 2016 – 0944 hours

An officer was dispatched to Upper Hillside Drive on a barking dog complaint. A written warning was issued to the dog owner.

April 29, 2016 – 1410 hours

A panic alarm activation was reported on Amy Brooke Circle. The homeowner advised she did not set off the alarm. The alarm company was contacted. False alarm.



April 30, 2016 – 0045 hours

While on a business security check officers observed a vehicle with 3 occupants pull into the parking lot. Two passengers got out of the vehicle and staggered into the business. Officers checked on both passengers and the driver when they were getting back in the vehicle. The 17-year old driver from Centerville was found to be impaired. The driver was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The driver was released to his parents. The two juvenile passengers were released to relatives.

April 30, 2016 – 0617 hours

A resident on Upper Bellbrook Road reported that unknown subject(s) had rummaged through two of his unlocked vehicles and stolen loose change. The complainant was advised to lock his vehicles in the future.

April 30, 2016 – 0922 hours

A resident on North West Street reported that his unlocked vehicle had been rummaged through. Nothing was taken from the vehicle. The complainant was advised to lock his vehicle in the future.

April 30, 2016 – 1219 hours

An unlocked vehicle on Ridgeway Road had been rummaged through by unknown subject(s). The owner advised that a Catholic rosary had been taken. The complainant was advised to lock his vehicle in the future.

A resident on Shore Drive reported that unknown person(s) had gone through his unlocked vehicle and taken loose change. The complainant was advised to lock his vehicle in the future.

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street on the report of a domestic dispute. A 14-year old juvenile was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Domestic Violence and picked up by a relative to separate her from the victim.
