May 8, 2016 – 0135 hours

An officer found an open garage door on Upper Hillside Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who secured the door.

May 9, 2016 – 0244 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Bellemeade Drive for several equipment violations. Officers located an open can of an alcoholic beverage in the vehicle and the 36-year old driver admitted to having drugs in his vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Open Container, Drug Paraphernalia, Drug Abuse, No Rear License Plate Light, and Defective Muffler.

May 9, 2016 – 1624 hours

An officer was dispatched to the area of North Sheffield Drive on the report of a female involved in door-to-door sales. The officer located the subject on East Carmela Court. She was advised that she needed a soliciting permit and was ordered to cease her activity. The female left the area without further incident.

May 9, 2016 – 1802 hours

An officer was dispatched to South West Street on the report of an unlicensed / inoperable vehicle on private property. The owner was contacted and explained of the City ordinance for unlicensed / inoperable vehicles. The owner was given 10 days to make the vehicle operable or remove it from his property.

May 9, 2016 – 1831 hours

An officer was dispatched to Sullivan Drive for two inoperable vehicles with expired registration on private property. The City ordinance was explained to the vehicle owner, who was advised to get proper registration for his vehicle and make them operable or remove them from the property within 10 days.



May 9, 2016 – 1907 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street due to having knowledge that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 27-year old female driver from Spring Valley was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension. Further investigation revealed that a passenger in the vehicle, a 28-year old female from Spring Valley had two active warrants for her arrest. She was taken into custody and turned over to the Warren County Sheriff's Department.

May 10, 2016 – 1124 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving several bad checks. Investigation revealed the checks were stolen. The case has been assigned to a detective.

May 10, 2016 – 1403 hours

Officers were dispatched to Bledsoe Drive on the report of a burglary in progress. The complainant advised that when she arrived home and upon pulling in her driveway she observed an unknown female exiting the front door of the house. The suspect took off running. Jewelry and other items were stolen from the home. The case has been assigned to a detective.

May 10, 2016 – 1403 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Bledsoe Drive for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 37-year old driver did not have an active driver's license. Drug tools and paraphernalia were found in the vehicle. The suspect was arrested and charged with Driving under Suspension, Possession of Criminal Tools, and Drug Paraphernalia. He was transported to the Greene County Jail for incarceration.



May 10, 2016 – 1741 hours

A dog bite was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road. The complainant advised that while he was trying to separate his own dogs from fighting he was bit in the hand. A medic was dispatched to take care of the victim's injury.

May 10, 2016 – 1845 hours

An assault was reported on Ryder Court. Investigation led to the suspect being transported to the hospital for a self-inflicted injury, and criminal charges filed against the 37-year old male for Unlawful Restraint.

May 11, 2016 – 0039 hours

While on routine patrol on Washington Mill Road, an officer observed a dome light on in a vehicle parked in a driveway. Contact was made with the owner who checked the vehicle to assure that nothing was missing. Everything checked ok.

May 11, 2016 – 0700 hours

An officer found an open window at a business in the Bellbrook Plaza. The building was checked and no sign of criminal activity was found. The officer secured the window.

May 12, 2016 – 0121 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Vemco Drive for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 50-year old driver from Bellbrook was impaired. The suspect was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and No License Plate Light. He was released to a relative.

May 12, 2016 – 0325 hours

While on routine patrol an officer found an open door at a business on State Route 725. The building was checked and no sign of criminal activity was found. The business owner was notified and the door was re-secured.



May 12, 2016 – 1150 hours

An officer was dispatched to Possum Run Road on the report of an unlicensed and inoperable vehicle on private property. The owner was contacted and the City ordinance was explained. The owner was given 10 days to get proper registration for the vehicle and make the vehicle operable or remove it from his property.

May 12, 2016 – 1152 hours

An officer responded to Belair Circle where he located an abandoned vehicle with a flat tire on the roadway. The owner was located and explained of the City ordinance for abandoned vehicles. The owner was told that the vehicle had to be removed from the roadway within 10 days.

May 12, 2016 – 2306 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for several moving violations. Investigation revealed that the 34-year old driver from Gainesville, Florida was impaired. He was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Failure to Stay in Marked Lanes, and Following Too Close. He was released to a friend.

May 13, 2016 – 1432 hours

Criminal damaging was reported on North Main Street. The complainant advised that three glass window panes on a garage door had been damaged by what appeared BB's or airsoft pellets. There are no suspect(s) at this time.

May 13, 2016 – 1600 hours

A resident on Chelsea Drive reported that her vehicle had been rummaged through by unknown subject(s) and a GPS unit had been stolen from the vehicle.



May 13, 2016 – 2258 hours

While on bike patrol, an officer found an open door at a business on East Franklin Street. The business owner was contacted and the building was checked. There were no signs of criminal activity. The business owner re-secured the door.

While on a traffic stop on North Belleview Drive, the officer heard yelling coming from the area of Woodacre Drive. A second officer responded to Woodacre Drive and located a party in a backyard. The homeowner was advised that her party was too loud and given a verbal warning.
