May 15, 2016 – 1305 hours

Officers were dispatched to South East Street on a Theft from a detached garage. The case was assigned to a detective.

May 16, 2016 – 1256 hours

Criminal Damaging was reported on Brewsters Run Court. Unknown subject(s) had thrown a rock at a window of the complainant's home, shattering it.

May 16, 2016 – 1751 hours

A barking dog was reported on Justin Court. Contact was made with the owner and a written warning was issued.

May 16, 2016 – 1840 hours

Telephone Harassment was reported on Woodedge Drive. The complainant reported receiving threatening text messages. Contact was made with the suspect who was issued a written warning and ordered to cease all contact with the victim.

May 17, 2016 – 2211 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located an occupied vehicle at McGee Park after closing hours. Contact was made with the occupants who advised they had come to the park to talk. The officer explained that the park was closed and ordered them to leave the area.

May 17, 2016 – 2216 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on Hillrise Circle. Investigation led to the arrest of a 27-year old male from Bellbrook for Domestic Violence and Assault. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail for incarceration.



May 18, 2016 – 0924 hours

A subject arrived at post and reported that an unknown subject had opened a store charge account in his name and had ordered merchandise that was shipped to Florida. Contact was made with the merchant and the account was closed. The victim was given advice to protect his identity in the future.

May 18, 2016 – 1214 hours

Officers were dispatched to Wentworth Village Drive for an intrusion alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the alarm was set off accidentally.

May 18, 2016 – 1638 hours

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street on the report of an intrusion alarm activation. Investigation revealed that there was no emergency and that the alarm had been set off by accident.

May 18, 2016 – 1845 hours

A disturbance was reported at the park on Washington Mill Road. Contact was made with all the parties involved, and it was learned that a verbal domestic dispute had occurred. No charges were filed.

May 18, 2016 – 2132 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road. A vehicle that was stopped and in the process of turning into a driveway was rear ended by another vehicle. The driver at fault, a 23-year old male from Kettering, was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to maintain Assured Clear Distance.



May 20, 2016 – 0852 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Weller Drive. A vehicle traveling East on Weller Drive sideswiped a parked vehicle damaging the driver-side mirror. The 73-year old driver at fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.

May 20, 2016 – 1000 hours

Officers were dispatched to Vineyards Way on a panic alarm activation. Electrical problems were the cause of the alarm activation. Confirmed false alarm.

May 20, 2016 – 1202 hours

Identity Theft was reported by a resident on Sugar Leaf Drive. The complainant advised that an unknown subject had opened a credit card in her name and used it to purchase furniture from a store in Wisconsin. The bank was contacted and the account was closed. The victim was given advice to protect her identity in the future.

May 20, 2016 – 1314 hours

A hit-skip accident was reported on South Lakeman Drive. An unknown vehicle had hit a large pine bush in the front yard of the complainant's home and then left the scene in an unknown direction. Report taken.

May 20, 2016 – 1417 hours

An officer was dispatched to Hillcrest Drive where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

May 20, 2016 – 1520 hours

A traffic accident was reported on private property at the Bellbrook Plaza. A vehicle pulling into a parking spot struck another vehicle backing out of a parking spot. Insurance information was exchanged between the involved drivers.



May 21, 2016 – 1830 hours

A routine registration check of a vehicle traveling on South Linda Drive revealed that the driver of the vehicle did not have a valid driver's license. The vehicle was stopped on State Route 725. The 37-year old female driver from Kettering was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

May 21, 2016 – 2137 hours

An officer made contact with a resident on Sullivan Drive whose vehicle had been parked on the roadway for months without moving it. The owner advised that the vehicle is inoperable. He was given a 10-day warning to have the vehicle removed.
