**May 22, 2016 – 0734 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after a registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 33-year old male driver from Xenia was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**May 22, 2016 – 1014 hours**

An officer was dispatched to West Franklin Street where a female had locked her keys in her car. The officer was able to assist the female in gaining entry into her vehicle.

**May 23, 2016 – 0204 hours**

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township and Centerville Police departments in attempting to locate an Assault suspect in the area of Pelbrook Farm Drive. The officers assisted until no longer needed.

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road for having only one working brake light. Investigation revealed that the 20-year old driver from Centerville did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

An officer was dispatched to Lakeman Drive on a Fraud complaint. The complainant advised that he received an e-mail from a person posing as a friend, advising the complainant he was



in the Philippines and was requesting money due to a lost passport and for hotel bills. The complainant advised he knew that his friend was not in the Philippines, and that it was a fraud. The complainant was warned about opening e-mails from unknown persons.
