**May 29, 2016 – 0058 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that a 19-year old female passenger from Kettering was extremely intoxicated. The driver of the vehicle was issued a warning for No License Plate Light. The passenger was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Underage Consumption.

**May 29, 2016 – 0130 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 35-year old driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was also wanted on an active warrant from Dayton Police Department. The suspect was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension. She was then transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition by Dayton Police Department.

**May 29, 2016 – 0223 hours**

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with an alarm activation at a business on Wilmington Pike. The business was checked and found to be secure. No signs of criminal activity.

**May 29, 2016 – 2212 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on Vineyard Way Drive. The 17-year old female from Bellbrook was traveling South on Little Sugarcreek and attempting to turn onto Vineyard Way Drive. The driver lost control of the vehicle, drove into the other lane of travel and struck a curb, resulting in extensive damage to the vehicle. The female was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Control.

**May 30, 2016 – 0052 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer located a vehicle with 4 occupants at Eagle Land Park after dark. The subjects were advised the park was closed and ordered to leave the area.



**May 30, 2016 – 0214 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 22-year old driver from Centerville was impaired. He was taken into custody, and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated. The suspect was released to a relative.

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a Speed violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old driver from Hollansburg, Ohio, did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.
