June 12, 2016 – 1928 hours

An officer was flagged down by a subject sitting in a vehicle on Shadowood Circle. The subject appeared to be impaired. Further investigation led to the arrest of the 19-year old male from Kettering for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated.

June 13, 2016 – 0923 hours

A resident on Sugar Maple Place reported a relative as being late in returning from an out of state trip. The subject was located the next day and found to be fine.

June 13, 2016 – 1105 hours

An officer was dispatched to a construction site on Sugar Maple Place on the report of an overturned dump truck. There were no injuries reported. The officer and a State Highway Patrol Trooper stood by until the dump truck was towed from the scene.

June 13, 2016 – 1747 hours

While on stationary patrol on Beechwood Drive, an officer observed a subject going door to door. The officer made contact with the subject who admitted he was soliciting business for this lawn care company. The officer issued a written warning for Soliciting without a Permit, and ordered the subject to cease his activity.

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a moving violation. Upon contact with the driver, the officer noticed an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Investigation led to the 22-year old female driver from Kentucky being cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

An officer assisted a subject with a flat tire in the parking lot of a State Route 725 business.

A resident on Hess Road reported finding a fraudulent charge on his credit card account. Contact was made with the bank, and the account was closed.

She was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Driving under Suspension.

Officers were dispatched to Marcia Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. The residence was secure with no evidence of attempted forced entry. A key holder arrived on scene and confirmed that everything was ok.
