**June 19, 2016 – 0147 hours**

An officer located three juveniles walking on the bike path on West Franklin Street past curfew hours. Contact was made with the juveniles' parents, who were all advised of the curfew violation.

**June 19, 2016 – 1650 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Fowler Drive on the report of a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure. False alarm.

**June 20, 2016 – 2105 hours**

Officers met with a Tampico Trail resident about an unwanted person. Further investigation led to a 34-year old male being trespassed from the property.

**June 21, 2016 – 0353 hours**

While on bike patrol, an officer located an open garage door on Kensington Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who checked the garage to verify that nothing was missing and then closed the door.

**June 21, 2016 – 1851 hours**

Officers were dispatched to West Carmella Court on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure. False alarm.

**June 22, 2016 – 0053 hours**

An officer located two juveniles on the bike path near Sugar Run Trail past curfew hours. Contact was made with the parent who was informed of the curfew ordinance. The parent responded to the scene to pick up the boys.



### **June 22, 2016 – 2025 hours**

An officer was dispatched to the area of West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road where a juvenile had made a remark to a complete stranger that he was running away from home. The juvenile was located and he advised that he had been in an argument with a sibling before leaving his home. The 11-year old male was strongly admonished about his actions.

### **June 23, 2016 – 0024 hours**

An officer located an open garage door on South Linda Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who secured the door.

### **June 23, 2016 – 0136 hours**

A traffic stop for an equipment violation was conducted on Wilmington-Dayton Road. Investigation revealed that the 21-year old driver from Centerville was impaired. Officers located pills in the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Drug Abuse.

### **June 23, 2016 – 0900 hours**

A resident arrived at post to report that an unknown subject had used her credit card information and made purchases on her account totaling over \$800.00. The complainant advised that her spouse's credit card had also been compromised. Contact was made with the bank and the account was closed. The complainant was given advice about protecting herself from future identity theft.

### **June 23, 2016 – 1057 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Shiraz Court on a theft report. The complainant advised that he was in the military and had recently moved back to Bellbrook after being stationed in Germany. After his belongings were shipped overseas to Bellbrook, he found several items missing, and others damaged. The case was referred to the Wright Patt Air Force Base authorities to handle this case.



**June 23, 2016 – 1827 hours**

A theft from an unlocked vehicle was reported on Mill Run Lane. The complainant advised that her purse with cash, tools, and a tablet had been taken from the vehicle. The complainant was advised to always lock her vehicle. No suspects at this time.

**June 24, 2016 – 1442 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Lakeview Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival it was learned that a technician from the alarm company was repairing the system, and had set off the alarm. False alarm.

**June 25, 2016 – 0100 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 32-year old suspect from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**June 25, 2016 – 1656 hours**

A private property accident was reported in the parking lot of a business on East Franklin Street. The driver at-fault first struck the building, and then continued to travel through the parking lot, striking a vehicle. A Greene County Building Inspector was dispatched to assess the structure. The 25-year old female driver from Xenia was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.

An officer stopped a vehicle for a Speed violation on Washington Mill Road. Investigation revealed that the 31-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Speed.
