July 3, 2016 – 1007 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a road closure on Washington Mill Road due to a tree and power lines down in the roadway.

July 3, 2016 – 2153 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license. During the stop, marijuana was also located inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, and Drug Abuse. He was given a warning for Two Brake Lights Required.

July 4, 2016 – 0256 hours

While on routine patrol an officer found an open garage door on Tampico Trail. Contact was made with the homeowner who closed the door.

July 4, 2016 – 1703 hours

An officer was dispatched South Main Street on a harassment complaint. The complainant advised that she had received numerous phone calls and text messages from a person she has an active protection order against. The 37-year old suspect from Springfield was located driving in the downtown area, and stopped after learning that suspect did not have a valid driver's license. He was taken into custody and charged with two counts of Violation of a Protection Order, and Driving under Suspension. The suspected was transported to the Greene County Jail.

July 4, 2016 – 2004 hours

A resident on Ryder Court reported that her vehicle had been damaged. She had found scratches and dents on it. It was unknown where the damage occurred or who was responsible for it.



July 5, 2016 -0001 hours

A resident on Chelsea Drive reported a theft from his vehicle that had occurred sometime during the night. Unknown subject(s) had taken tools and some miscellaneous electronics from the car. The complainant advised that the had left the vehicle unlocked.

July 5, 2016 – 1644 hours

An officer was dispatched to Wilmington-Dayton Road on the report of two dogs running loose along the roadway. The officer located the canines that did not have any collars or tags. Greene County Animal Control responded to pick up the dogs.

July 5, 2016 – 1918 hours

An officer responded to Clearview Drive where the resident reported that his juvenile son had found some tools in the bushes behind a business on State Route 725. Some of the found items belonged to the subject who had tools stolen from his vehicle on Chelsea Drive early that morning. The items were returned to the owner.

July 6, 2016 – 0147 hours

A traffic stop was conducted on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 27-year old male driver from Kettering was impaired. The suspect was charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Seatbelt Required, and No Rear License Plate.

July 6, 2016 – 0545 hours

An officer conducted a traffic stop after observing a subject driving on West Franklin Street knowing that the driver did not to have a valid driver's license. The 56-year old male from Spring Valley was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



July 7, 2016 – 0139 hours

An officer was dispatched to Gary Drive on the report of fireworks in the area. Upon arrival, the officer did not hear any fireworks. The officer checked and remained in the area for quite some time, but did not hear or locate anyone setting off fireworks.

July 7, 2016 – 1246 hours

An officer observed a vehicle drive into the parking lot of a business on East Franklin Street. A routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 42-year old male from Franklin was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

July 7, 2016 – 1315 hours

A complaint of identity theft was reported by a subject working at a business on State Route 725. The complainant reported that he had found fraudulent charges totaling over \$10,500.00 on his business account. After checking his personal bank account he found additional fraudulent charges amounting over \$1,300.00. A personal credit card had also been compromised. The case has been assigned to a detective.

July 8, 2016 – 0235 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Mill Pond Drive after a routine registration checked revealed that the driver had an expired driver's license. Further investigation revealed that the 50-year old female driver from Bellbrook was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Expired Driver's License.

July 8, 2016 – 2253 hours

An officer located an open garage on West Franklin Street with two vehicles inside. Attempts to make contact with the residents were unsuccessful. The officer closed the garage door and resumed his patrol.



July 9, 2016 – 0437 hours

A resident on Bonniedale Drive reported that an unknown subject was sleeping on her front porch. Upon arrival the officers located a subject sleeping on porch furniture. The 22-year old male from Clearview Drive was woken up, and found to be intoxicated. A relative was called to pick up the subject.

July 9, 2016 – 1317 hours

An officer was dispatched to the parking lot of a business on State Route 725 where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

July 9, 2016 – 1749 hours

Officers were dispatched to Locus Bend Drive on an alarm activation. The house was found to be secure. Confirmed false alarm.

July 9, 2016 – 1913 hours

An officer stopped a motorcycle on West Franklin Street due to it having an extremely loud exhaust. Investigation revealed that the rider did not have a motorcycle endorsement on his driver's license and that his driver's license was suspended. The 39-year old male from Vandalia was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Driving without a Valid Driver's License, and Defective Muffler.

July 9, 2016 – 2142 hours

Officers were dispatched to Hess Road on the report of a disturbance. Two relatives that were intoxicated had been in a domestic dispute and during the altercation a window of the residence on Hess Road, and a windshield of the other suspect's vehicle were broken. An open container of an alcoholic beverage was located inside the vehicle. A 62-year old male from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Criminal Damaging and Open Container.



His vehicle was towed from the scene. His relative, a 45-year old male from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Criminal Damaging and Disorderly Conduct.
