**July 17, 2016 – 0025 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that a 42-year old passenger from Owensville, KY, had a warrant out for his arrest through the Greene County Sheriff's Department. The subject was taken into custody and turned over to a Greene County Sheriff's Deputy.

**July 18, 2016 – 0935 hours**

An officer was dispatched to East Maple Street on the report of low hanging electrical wires. The road was closed until the utility company made the scene safe.

**July 18, 2016 – 1145 hours**

A barking dog complaint was received on South Lakeman Drive. Contact was made with the dog owner who was given a verbal warning. The owner took the dog inside the home.

**July 18, 2016 – 1159 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Portage Path Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure.

**July 18, 2016 – 2015 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Belleview Drive for two equipment violations. The driver was issued warnings for No Front License Plate and Two Brake Lights required. Investigation revealed that one of the passengers in the vehicle was wanted on a warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. The 27-year old male from Springfield was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

**July 19, 2016 – 0132 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported at a business on North West Street. The officer located the vehicle and made contact with the driver and occupant. The 19-year old driver from Bellbrook advised that he and his friend were playing the Pokemon Go game.



**July 19, 2016 – 0352 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer located an open garage door on Sable Ridge Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who closed the door and thanked the officer.

**July 19, 2016 – 1634 hours**

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street on a past-occurred domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. No charges were filed.

**July 20, 2016 – 0316 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an open rear door at a business on State Route 725. The business checked secure. A message was left for the business owner.

**July 20, 2016 – 1510 hours**

An officer observed a subject involved in door-to-door sales on South Linda Drive. Contact was made with the subject who did not have a solicitor's permit. He was ordered to cease his activity and issued a verbal warning.

**July 22, 2016 – 0754 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Beryl Drive on a panic alarm activation. Upon arrival, the homeowner advised that he had accidentally set off the alarm.

**July 22, 2016 – 0810 hours**

A resident on Gunther Drive reported that he had fallen victim to a fraud when attempting to buy a vehicle from Ebay. He advised that he had sent the alleged seller of the vehicle a total of \$3,500.00 in pre-paid credit cards. The seller had originally told the buyer that the vehicle was in Kettering, but later was advised that the vehicle was in South Carolina. The vehicle was never delivered to the buyer. There is no suspect at this time.



**July 22, 2016 – 2048 hours**

A wallet was found on Bledsoe Drive near the park. The wallet belonged to a juvenile living in Sugarcreek Township. The officer returned the wallet to the juvenile's mother.

**July 23, 2016 – 1541 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on the report of an unwanted subject inside the complainant's residence. Upon arrival it was learned that an estranged partner had entered the residence with a key she had been given by the complainant and was dropping off some property. The complainant requested the key back, and wanted the female to leave the property. She did so without further incident.

**July 23, 2016 – 1617 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Upper Hillside Drive on the report of subjects involved in door-to-door sales. The subjects were located and told to cease their activity without a solicitor's permit. Officers were then dispatched to Possum Run Road and South Lakeman Drive for subjects from the same company going door-to-door. They were also ordered to cease their activity and to leave the area.

**July 23, 2016 – 1704 hours**

Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of a business on East Franklin Street on the report of a highly intoxicated subject. The suspect would not give his name or identification to the officers. The suspect, a 47-year old male from Spring Valley was taken into custody for Obstructing Official Business and Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.
