July 24, 2016 – 2151 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 26-year old driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Two Headlights Required.

July 24, 2016 – 2209 hours

An officer was dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on the report of a loud party. Upon arrival, the officer could hear loud music and people talking over the music. They were told to quiet down the music and party. No further problems were reported.

July 26, 2016 – 1037 hours

Officers were dispatched to Barnett Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival, the resident advised that he had accidentally set off the alarm.

July 26, 2016 – 1320 hours

An officer was dispatched to East Sudbury Court where the complainant reported an unknown vehicle was parked in his driveway. Investigation revealed that the vehicle belonged to a neighbor, who had parked the vehicle in his driveway due to the street being paved that day. The complainant advised the vehicle could be left in his driveway.

July 26, 2016 – 1328 hours

A men's bicycle was found at a business on South Lakeman Drive. The bicycle was taken to the police department and may be claimed by the owner after proper identification.

July 26, 2016 – 1805 hours

Telephone harassment was reported on Shadowood Court. The complainant advised that a female was calling his live-in grandson over fifty times a day. While the officer was taking the report, the female called and the officer spoke to her about the complaint. The female was



ordered to stop her phone calls to the home. While the officer continued to speak with her, the female advised that the complainant's grandson was hiding drugs inside his grandfather's vehicle. The grandfather requested a search of his vehicle. Inside, a baggy of marijuana and drug paraphernalia were located. The grandson, a 21-year old male was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Possession and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

July 27, 2016 – 2312 hours

An officer was dispatched to West Franklin Street on a suspicious vehicle complaint. Investigation revealed that the vehicle belonged to a neighbor's friend.

July 28, 2016 – 1241 hours

An officer was dispatched to Hess Road on a complaint about tree trimmers. The complainant advised she thought that tree trimmers from Pavilion Lane were cutting her trees down. Investigation revealed a neighbor had hired them to cut down four dead trees on his property only. The complainant advised that the crew could be on her property to perform the work.

July 28, 2016 – 1631 hours

An officer assisted Sugarcreek Township Police Department on Pine View Drive with a possible burglary in progress. The complainant advised she was in the upstairs of her home when she heard glass breaking in her basement. She hid in a closet until officers arrived on scene. The interior and exterior of the home checked secure. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

July 28, 2016 -1649 hours

A handicap placard was found at a business on West Franklin Street. The owner was located and the property was returned to him.



July 28, 2016 – 0952 hours

While on routine patrol an officer heard a car alarm coming from a vehicle on Mission Lane. Contact was made with the owner who advised she must have accidentally pushed to panic button on the key fob.

July 30, 2016 – 0730 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for two equipment violations. Investigation revealed that a passenger, a 28-year old male from Bellbrook was wanted on a warrant from Kettering Police Department. The subject was arrested and custody was turned over to a Kettering Police Officer.

July 30, 2016 – 0930 hours

An officer was dispatched to Sugarwood Drive on the report of a hit/skip accident. The complainant advised that her vehicle had been struck while it had been parked on the street in front of her residence overnight. There was damage to the front left corner of the vehicle and the headlight assembly. No suspects at this time.

July 30, 2016 – 1024 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with an injury accident on Upper Bellbrook Road. The officer remained on the scene until no longer needed.

July 30, 2016 – 1542 hours
