July 31, 2016 – 0303 hours

Telephone harassment was reported on West Sudbury Court. The complainant advised he had received text message from a subject daring him to fight at Sackett Wright Park. Officers responded to the suspect's home on Crescent Court. The suspect claimed the complainant was harassing him, and daring him to fight. Both subjects were ordered to cease all contact.

July 31, 2016 – 1045 hours

A welfare check was requested on a Ryder Court resident who had not been seen or heard from by relatives for several days. Officers attempted contact on Ryder Court but the subject was not home. A check with neighbors revealed that they had observed the subject walking her dog that morning and that there were no problems. The information was relayed to the complainant.

July 31, 2016 – 2208 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a moving and equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the driver, a 39-year old male from Columbus was impaired. He was consequently arrested for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Lanes of Travel upon Roadways, and Two Brake Lights Required. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

August 1, 2016 – 0000 hrs

An officer was dispatched to Beechwood Drive on a harassment complaint. The complainant advised she was receiving harassing and threatening messages on Facebook from a co-worker. The 24-year old male suspect from Dayton was charged with Aggravated Menacing and Telecommunication Harassment. Officers attempted to serve the suspect his citations but it was learned that he had been arrested by Miami Township Police Department for a Probation Violation, and was incarcerated at the Montgomery County Jail. The suspect was interviewed and served his citations there.



August 1, 2016 – 0232 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 39-year old male driver from Springboro was impaired. The suspect was charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Drug Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Open Container of Liquor, and Lane of Travel upon Roadways. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.

August 1, 2016 – 1120 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with an injury traffic crash on Wilmington Pike near Whites Corner. The driver at-fault, a 66-year old male from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield.

August 2, 2016 – 0329 hours

While on bicycle patrol an officer located an open garage door on Locus Bend Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who closed the garage door and thanked the officer.

August 2, 2016 – 1930 hours

A neighbor dispute was reported on Tampico Trail. The complainant advised that his neighbor had thrown cat feces into his pool. The case remains active at this time.

August 2, 2016 – 2256 hours

An unwanted intoxicated subject was reported on Lower Hillside Drive. Contact was made with the female suspect, a 44-year old female from Bellbrook, who was standing outside of the complainant's residence. She was issued a written warning for Criminal Trespassing and ordered to leave the property. Approximately 2 hours later, the suspect returned to the complainant's home and was banging on doors and windows. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Criminal Trespassing.



August 3, 2016 – 1304 hours

A resident on North West Street reported she had recently fired a disgruntled employee. She advised that she had observed numerous suspicious persons and vehicles in the vicinity of her home since then. The officer did explain to the complainant that her home was nearby two gathering points for the Pokemon Go game, which has increased vehicle and foot traffic on North West Street. The complainant was advised the contact the department immediately when observing suspicious persons or vehicles, and extra patrol for her residence was initiated.

August 3, 2016 – 1659 hours

An officer was dispatched to the area of West Franklin Street near Vemco Drive on the report of a reckless vehicle that was swerving all over the road, and had nearly caused a collision. The officer located the vehicle on West Franklin Street near North West Street and stopped it. Investigation revealed that the 38-year old driver from Dayton was not impaired but did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Reinstate Driver's License.

August 3, 2016 – 1830 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street on the report of a disoriented elderly female. Upon contact, it was learned that the female was experiencing some medical issues. The Bellbrook Fire Department transported the female to the hospital for treatment.

August 3, 2016 – 2212 hours

A suspicious parked vehicle was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road. An officer made contact with the 26-year old occupant from Gahanna, Ohio, who advised he was playing the Pokemon Go game.



August 4, 2016 – 0115 hours

Officers were dispatched to North Lakeman Drive to assist Sugarcreek Township Police Officers with a subject who had overdosed, but was now combative and violently fighting the complainant. The officers stood by until the subject was removed from the home and transported to the hospital.

August 4, 2016 – 1350 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported received a Bad Check. Contact was made with the suspect, who responded to the business and paid the bad check and fees.

August 4, 2016 – 1717 hours

A private property accident with minor damage was reported in the parking lot of a business on West Franklin Street. The vehicle owners exchanged information for insurance purposes.

August 4, 2016 – 1837 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on the report of a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival it was learned that the homeowner had accidentally set off the alarm.

August 5, 2016 – 1836 hours

Officers were dispatched to Shadowood Circle on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. No charges filed.

August 6, 2016 – 0209 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 32-year male driver from Xenia was impaired. It was also learned that he did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Driving Under Suspension, and Defective Muffler. A passenger in the vehicle, a 27-year old male from Xenia, was highly intoxicated and had to be taken to the hospital for possible alcohol poisoning. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication.
