**August 7, 2016 – 2009 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Lower Hillside Drive on the report of an unwanted subject. Investigation led to a 45-year old female from Xenia being criminally trespassed from the property.

**August 7, 2016 – 2115 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on South Main Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 21-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and issued a written warning for Two Headlights Required.

**August 8, 2016 – 0245 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an open door at a Bellbrook Plaza business. Contact was made with the business owner who responded to re-secure the door.

**August 8, 2016 – 0703 hours**

A domestic dispute was reported on Shadowleaf Drive. Investigation resulted in the arrest of a 47-year old female for Domestic Violence and Assault. She was transported to the Greene County Jail.

**August 8, 2016 – 1327 hours**

A private property accident was reported on Kensington Drive where a vehicle struck a fire hydrant. Report taken.

**August 8, 2016 – 2141 hours**

Officers responded to South Main Street on the report of an unwanted person. Investigation led to a 34-year old male from Bellbrook being criminally trespassed from the property.



**August 8, 2016 – 2204 hours**

Officers were dispatched to North Field Drive for a Suspicious Vehicle complaint. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the 16-year old driver who advised he and his friends were waiting to go to a friend's house in Sugarcreek Township, but could not go there until midnight. Upon further investigation the driver admitted to having drugs and drug paraphernalia in the trunk of his vehicle. The driver and the three juvenile occupants were picked up and released to their parents. The 16-year old driver from Bellbrook was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**August 9, 2016 – 0746 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Sugarcreek Drive on the report of a Theft from three vehicles. The complainant advised that three vehicles parked in her driveway had been unlocked during the overnight hours, and that someone had entered all three vehicles and taken loose change from them.

**August 9, 2016 – 0830 hours**

A resident on North Linda Drive reported a Theft from her vehicle. The vehicle had been unlocked when someone entered the vehicle and stole a laptop and loose change from it.

**August 9, 2016 – 1049 hours**

A Theft from a vehicle was reported on North Linda Drive. The vehicle had been unlocked during the overnight hours when someone entered it and taken loose change and cigarettes from it.

**August 9, 2016 – 1110 hours**

An officer assisted the Bellbrook Zoning Department with a complaint of chickens in the backyard of a property on South Linda Drive. The officer issued the owner a written warning for Certain Animals Prohibited. The owner was given 10 days to remove the chickens from his property.



**August 9, 2016 – 1311 hours**

A resident on Washington Mill Road reported receiving some packages with merchandise she did not buy. She contacted the store and learned that someone had opened a credit card in her name. When she contacted the credit bureaus to report the fraud she was told that several other credit card accounts had been opened in her name. All accounts were closed and the case was assigned to a detective.

**August 9, 2016 – 2154 hours**

An officer located a suspicious vehicle at Eagle Land Park on South East Street. Contact was made with the driver and occupant who advised they were there to talk. The officer explained to them that the park was closed, and told them to leave the area.

**August 10, 2016 – 0021 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on the report of a Domestic Dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature and no violence had occurred.

**August 10, 2016 – 1730 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road. Investigation revealed that the 30-year old driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**August 11, 2016 – 0705 hours**

An officer was flagged down by a female who had found a dog running loose on Wilmington-Dayton Road. The dog did not have a collar or dog tags, and was transported to the Greene County Animal Control shelter in Xenia.



**August 11, 2016 – 1510 hours**

A juvenile problem was reported on West Franklin Street. The complainant advised that she had gotten into a verbal altercation with her great-grandson after finding drugs and drug paraphernalia in his bathroom and his coat. The 16-year old male was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**August 11, 2016 – 1903 hours**

A Hit-and-Run accident was reported on Viewpoint Drive. The complainant advised an unknown vehicle had backed into her vehicle overnight, causing minor damage to the front bumper of her vehicle. Report taken.

**August 11, 2016 – 2237 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on the report of a Suspicious Vehicle that had been parked there with its' lights flashing. Investigation revealed that the vehicle had a malfunctioning headlight switch causing the lights to blink. The owner disconnected the battery cable to correct the problem.

**August 12, 2016 – 0120 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer observed a male subject running from Mill Pond Drive to Chelsea Drive. The subject tried to get away from the officer by hiding behind a vehicle. The officer was able to make contact with the subject, who was intoxicated and advised he did not want to get in trouble, and therefor had run from the officer. The suspect was ordered to go to his home on Chelsea Drive and stay inside for the rest of the night.

**August 12, 2016 – 0141 hours**

An officer located an open garage door on Jacobs Hill Court. Contact was made with the homeowner who re-secured the door.

An officer stopped a vehicle on South Linda Drive for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 25-year old driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Defective Muffler.

A resident on Sugar Run Trail advised that an unknown subject had removed her vehicle battery from her car, and replaced it with a dead battery. Report taken.
