**August 14, 2016 – 0208 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Ambridge Lane for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 40-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and was given a verbal warning for Defective Muffler.

**August 15, 2016 – 0035 hours**

Officers assisted the Beavercreek Police Department with an attempt to locate a suspect on Moss Oak Trail. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old male no longer was living at the residence, and had moved to Beavercreek.

**August 15, 2016 – 0116 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Streamview Court on the report of a traffic hazard. Upon arrival the officer located a tree that had fallen and was blocking the roadway. The Bellbrook Service Department was notified to remove the tree.

**August 15, 2016 – 0118 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after observing the vehicle swaying all over the roadway. Investigation revealed that the 39-year old male from Waynesville was impaired. The suspect also had a firearm in his vehicle. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Using Weapons while Intoxicated, and Lane of Travel upon Roadways.

**August 15, 2016 – 1112 hours**

A resident on Marcia Drive reported that an unknown subject had used his information to open an account with a cellular phone company, and charged over \$4000.00 to the account. The account had been turned over to a collection company. Report taken.



**August 15, 2016 – 1159 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Vemco Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival, the homeowner advised that she had accidentally set off the alarm.

**August 16, 2016 – 0428 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an open door at a business on State Route 725. The interior of the business was checked and there were no signs of criminal activity. The officer stood by until a key holder arrived to re-secure the business.

**August 16, 2016 – 1053 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Sheffield Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure.

**August 16, 2016 – 1927 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 48-year old male driver from Piqua had an active warrant for his arrest from the Shelby County Sheriff's Department. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

**August 17, 2016 – 0203 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Sugar Run Trail on the report of an unwanted subject. A 29-year old male from Dayton was criminally trespassed from the property.

An officer was dispatched to a business on State Route 725 where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.



**August 18, 2016 – 1549 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Eckworth Drive after a routine registration check revealed that the 21-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. Further investigation revealed that the suspect had an active warrant for his arrest. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail. He was issued a citation for Driving under Suspension.

**August 18, 2016 – 1812 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on State Route 725. The officer assisted by pushing the vehicle off the roadway and into a parking lot.

**August 19, 2016 – 1827 hours**

An injury accident was reported on East Franklin Street. A vehicle failed to yield at the stop sign on South East Street and collided with a vehicle traveling on East Franklin Street. The driver at-fault, a 16-year old female from Bellbrook was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign. Both vehicles had to be towed from the scene.

**August 20, 2016 – 2129 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an unoccupied disabled vehicle on West Franklin Street. Contact was made with the vehicle owner who responded to meet with the officers. The officers assisted the owner by pushing the vehicle into a parking lot. A tow company was called to pick up the vehicle.
