August 21, 2016 – 2215 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an expired vehicle registration. Investigation revealed that a 46-year old female passenger was wanted on two active warrants. She was transported to the Greene County Jail.

August 22, 2016 – 0116 hours

A loud music complaint was received on West Sudbury Court. Upon arrival, the officer made contact with the homeowner who was told to turn down the music. No further problems reported.

August 22, 2016 – 0404 hours

Officers were dispatched to Locus Bend Drive on the report of Domestic Violence. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature and no physical violence had taken place. The parties separated for the evening.

August 24, 2016 – 1655 hours

A resident on Mill Pond Drive reported being harassed on Facebook by a subject who lives on in New York. Contact was made with the suspect who was ordered to cease all communication with the complainant.

August 24, 2016 – 2238 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a registration and equipment violation. During the investigation, a baggy of marijuana was found inside the vehicle. The 23-year old male driver from Waynesville was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse.

A suspicious person was reportedly looking into windows on Jacobs Hill Court. An officer made contact with the subject who was a repairman working on the exterior of homes in the area.

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street on the report of an unwanted subject. Investigation led to a 61-year old male from Bellbrook being criminally trespassed from the residence.

August 27, 2016 – 0200 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 39-year old male driver from Spring Valley was impaired. The suspect was taken into custody for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated. He was issued a warning for No License Plate Light.

August 27, 2016 – 0328 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located an open garage door on Sable Ridge Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who closed the door.

August 27, 2016 – 0439 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for several equipment violations. Investigation revealed that the 20-year old driver from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Display of Vehicle Registration, and Tinted Windows.
