August 28, 2016 – 0125 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer located a 17-year old male walking on the bike path on West Franklin Street. A curfew violation notice was served the parent of the juvenile.

August 28, 2016 – 0304 hours

Officers responded to a business on State Route 725 on the report of a person lying in the parking lot. Investigation revealed that a 25-year old male from Centerville was highly intoxicated and had assaulted a female. The suspect was taken into custody and charged with Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication and Assault, and transported to the Greene County Jail.

August 28, 2016 – 1952 hours

While on routine patrol an officer was informed of a disorderly elderly female. The officer located the female on West Franklin Street. A relative was contacted who took the female back to her residence.

August 28, 2016 – 2028 hours

Officers were dispatched to Kensington Drive on the report of a disoriented female. The female was transported to the hospital by the Bellbrook Fire Department.

August 29, 2016 – 0041 hours

A dog at large was reported on Eckworth Drive. Upon arrival, the complainant was with the canine that did not have a collar or tags. The dog was transported to Greene County Animal Control.

August 29, 2016 – 1152 hours

An officer was dispatched to Nedra Drive on an Identity Theft complaint. The victim advised that an unknown person had used her identity to open a credit card in her name. Report taken.



August 29, 2016 – 1333 hours

An officer was dispatched to West Sudbury Court on the report of a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure. False alarm.

August 29, 2016 – 1620 hours

A traffic hazard was reported on Little Sugarcreek Road. Upon the officer's arrival, three large rocks were found on the roadway. The officer removed the rocks and resumed patrol.

August 30, 2016 – 1736 hours

An officer was dispatched to Kensington Drive on a neighbor complaint. Investigation led to a 62-year old male being criminally trespassed from his neighbor's residence.

August 30, 2016 – 1925 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. A 29-year old female from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

August 31, 2016 – 1517 hours

An officer was dispatched to Shadowleaf Drive on a welfare check. An OnStar client had activated an emergency button in her vehicle. The vehicle was located on Sugar Maple Place, and investigation revealed that a 2-year old child had accidentally activated the alert.

August 31, 2016 – 1926 hours

A subject locked his keys in his vehicle on North Linda Drive. An officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.



August 31, 2016 – 2150 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington Pike after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. A 19-year old male from Waynesville was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

September 1, 2016 – 1330 hours

A report of subjects involved in door-to-door sales was received on Cabernet Way. An officer located all subjects and ordered them to cease their activity, and gave them information about obtaining a solicitor permit.

September 1, 2016 – 1507 hours

A burglary alarm activation was reported on Possum Run Road. Upon the officer's arrival, the homeowner advised that an 11-year old child had accidentally set off the alarm.

September 2, 2016 – 2130 hours

Officers were dispatched to Bellemeade Drive on the report of theft from vehicles. The complainant advised that 2 of his 3 vehicles had been unlocked, and were entered by unknown subjects. A firearm and loose change was missing from the vehicles. The report was referred to a detective.

September 2, 2016 – 0157 hours

Officers were dispatched to Marcia Drive on the report of a drug overdose. Investigation led to charges filed against a 30-year old female for Possession of Criminal Tools. The female was transported to the hospital by the Bellbrook Fire Department. Additional charges are pending.

September 2, 2016 – 1013 hours

A business on West Franklin Street received three bad checks. The case was assigned to a detective.



September 3, 2016 – 0220 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver of the vehicle did not have a valid driver's license. The 24-year old female suspect from Xenia was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

September 3, 2016 – 1400 hours

A traffic crash was reported on Little Sugarcreek Road. A vehicle driving southbound traveled into the opposite lane of traffic causing another vehicle to swerve and hit a guardrail. The unknown suspect vehicle did not stop after the accident occurred.

September 3, 2016 – 2101 hours

Loud music was reported on Sullivan Drive. Officers made contact with the homeowner and told him to turn down the music. No additional complaints were received.
