September 4, 2016 – 0102 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 20-year old male driver from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Drug Abuse, and No License Plate Light. The suspect was incarcerated at the Greene County Jail.

September 4, 2016 – 0430 hours

Officers were dispatched to Woodedge Drive on a Theft report. The complainant advised that an unknown subject had rummaged through three of his vehicles, and stolen a bicycle. Report taken.

September 4, 2016 – 1435 hours

A resident on East Franklin Street reported that his dog was running loose in the area, and asked for help from an officer. The animal was located and the owner was able to catch the dog.

September 4, 2016 – 2127 hours

An unwanted person was reported at a business on West Franklin Street. A male subject from Bellbrook had reportedly harassed an employee of the business. The officers made contact with the subject, who had consumed some alcohol. A friend was called to pick up the suspect.

September 5, 2016 – 0102 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for two equipment violation. Investigation led to charges filed against the 22-year old male driver from Xenia for Possession of Criminal Tools, Drug Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Open Container of Liquor, Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing Official Business, and Resisting Arrest. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.



September 5, 2016 – 1532 hours

A resident on Portage Path reported that unknown subject(s) had used his credit card information to make purchases at grocery stores in the area, spending more than \$2,000.00. The case was assigned to a detective.

September 5, 2016 – 1710 hours

An officer was dispatched to Tampico Trail on the report of loud music. Contact was made with the homeowner who was advised of the complaint and told to turn the music down. No further complaints received.

September 6, 2016 – 2017 hours

Theft of a vehicle was reported on East Walnut Street. The report is under investigation.

September 7, 2016 – 1612 hours

A resident reported receiving a voicemail from an unknown subject advising that she was late in filing her taxes. She was told to return the call, or local police officers would arrest her. The complainant was advised that this is a known scam, and to ignore any future calls from this subject.

September 7, 2016 – 1931 hours

A verbal domestic dispute was reported on Woodedge Drive. The parties involved were separated. No charges were filed.

September 7, 2016 – 2228 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer located a disabled vehicle in the roadway on West Franklin Street, near Little Sugarcreek Rd. Officers were able to push the vehicle from the roadway into a parking lot where it remained until the vehicle was towed.



September 8, 2016 – 1536 hours

A private property traffic accident was reported on North Linda Drive. Both parties exchanged insurance information.

September 8, 2016 – 1617 hours

A verbal dispute was reported on Beechwood Drive. The involved parties separated after the argument.

September 8, 2016 – 2132 hours

A complaint of a dog running loose in the area of Vemco Drive was received. An officer located the dog which did not have any tags. Animal Control responded to pick up the canine.

September 9, 2016 – 2306 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located an open door at a business at Bellbrook Plaza. A key holder was contacted. The business checked secure, and officers locked the door.

September 10, 2016 – 0150 hours

An officer located a suspicious occupied vehicle parked on West Franklin Street. Contact was made with the driver, who advised she had gotten into a verbal argument with her partner, and had decided to leave her residence in Sugarcreek Township to calm down.

September 10, 2016 – 2051 hours

Officers were dispatched to McHenry Court on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation led to the arrest of a 69-year old male for Domestic Violence and Assault.
