**September 11, 2016 – 2256 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on the report of disorderly subjects throwing glass bottles and yelling. Investigation revealed that two intoxicated subjects had been arguing. Both were cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication.

**September 12, 2016 – 0750 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Woodacre Drive on a panic alarm activation. Upon the officer's arrival the homeowner explained he was experiencing a medical issue. Bellbrook medics were dispatched to treat the patient.

**September 13, 2016 – 1449 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Lakeview Drive to provide traffic and crowd control while the Bellbrook Fire Department extinguished a car fire. The officers stood by until no longer needed.

**September 14, 2016 – 0942 hours**

A resident on Lakeman Drive reported being harassed on Facebook by a known subject. The officer made contact with the suspect and ordered her to cease all contact with the complainant.

**September 14, 2016 – 1613 hours**

A report of a reckless drive was received on Spring Creek Circle. Officers made contact with the driver and advised him of the complaint. The suspect apologized for his driving behavior.

**September 14, 2016 – 1743 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Belair Circle on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation led to the arrest of a 41-year old male for Domestic Violence and Assault. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.



**September 14, 2016 – 2221 hours**

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road near Moss Oak Trail. Investigation revealed that a 37-year old female from Marimont, Ohio lost control of her vehicle while trying to turn into a driveway on Wilmington-Dayton Road. This caused her vehicle to go off the roadway. The female was found to be impaired and charged with Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Failure to Control.

**September 15, 2016 - 0017 hours**

A resident on Chelsea Drive reported that an unknown person had used some pictures of her and posted them to a dating website. The complainant was advised how to have her pictures removed from the website.

**September 15, 2016 – 1000 hours**

A debit card was found in Bellbrook Park on North Main Street. It was learned that the owner lives in Clinton County. The owner was contacted by a Clinton County deputy and later picked up the property.

**September 16, 2016 – 0956 hours**

An officer was flagged down on East Franklin Street by a subject who had found a wallet. Contact was made with the owner who later retrieved the property from the police department.

**September 16, 2016 – 1105 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 29-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



**September 16, 2016 – 1939 hours**

While taking a report on North Main Street, officers observed a dog running loose on the roadway. They were able to get a hold of the animal which did not have a collar or tags. Greene County Animal Control picked up the dog.

**September 17, 2016 – 0957 hours**

An officer was dispatched to a residence on West Franklin Street where a child was sitting outside of the home and could not get inside of the residence. Upon the officer's arrival, the child explained he had accidentally locked himself out of the home and could not get back in. His mother who was at work in Xenia was contacted, and she responded to her home to let her son in.

**September 17, 2016 – 1106 hours**

An officer was dispatched on the report of a disabled vehicle in the middle of the roadway on West Franklin Street. The officer remained on the scene until a tow arrived to remove the vehicle.

**September 17, 2016 – 1435 hours**

A credit card was found in the parking lot of a business on East Franklin Street. Contact was made with the owner who later responded to the police department to retrieve the property.

**September 17, 2016 – 2318 hours**

An officer assisted the Greene County Sheriff's Department with the arrest of a subject who resides on Ryder Court, wanted on a warrant. The suspect was taken into custody without incident.
