September 25, 2016 – 0333 hours

Officers were dispatched to Wilmington-Dayton Road on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation led to the arrest of a 28-year old male from Kettering for Domestic Violence and Assault. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.

September 25, 2016 – 1636 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 42-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, and No Seatbelt. He was issued a verbal warning for No Front License Plate.

September 25, 2016 – 1848 hours

Officers were dispatched to the area of West Franklin Street near South Linda Drive on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation led to the arrest of a 46-year old male from Xenia for Domestic Violence and Assault. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.

September 26, 2016 – 0904 hours

An officer was requested to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department in catching two dogs running loose in the area of Waynesville Road. Officers were able to retrieve one of the dogs. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

September 27, 2016 – 1704 hours

A resident on West Franklin Street reported receiving harassing phone calls from a person known to her. The suspect was contacted and ordered to cease all calls to the complainant.

September 28, 2016 – 0930 hours

An officer assisted a subject who had locked his keys in his vehicle at the City Building. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.



September 28, 2016 – 2230 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old driver from Waynesville did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

September 28, 2016 – 2307 hours

An officer was dispatched to the area of West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road on the report of a suspicious male. The officer located the subject, who advised he had been in a verbal altercation with his spouse and was walking back to his home.

September 29, 2016 – 1905 hours

A subject involved in door-to-door sales was reported on West Franklin Street. The 25-year old male from Chicago was located, and was attempting to sell magazines without a solicitor's permit. Officers explained the City ordinance for soliciting to the subject, and he was issued a written warning for soliciting without a permit. He was ordered to cease his activity.

September 30, 2016 – 0931 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer located a 2-year old child walking on Old Pepper Bend Drive without a parent nearby. The child knew where he lived and took the officer to his home. Upon arrival, contact was made with the mother, who was visibly upset and advised this was the first time the child had unlocked the door. The officer gave advice to the mother about securing the home.

A traffic accident was reported at the intersection of West Franklin Street and Bonniedale Drive. A 45-year old female from Xenia was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield.
