January 10, 2016 – 1047 hours

A vehicle backing out of driveway on Crescent Court accidentally struck another vehicle parked on the street. The driver at-fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Improper Backing.

January 10, 2016 – 1810 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for driving without headlights on during dark hours and swerving into the wrong lane of travel. Investigation led to the arrest of the 25-year old driver from Brookville for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, and Left of Center.

January 11, 2016 – 1935 hours

An officer was dispatched on the report of a disabled vehicle at Bellbrook Plaza. The vehicle was left in the parking lot, and the driver was given a ride home.

January 11, 2016 – 2111 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle for driving with only one working headlight, and no front license plate. Investigation revealed that the 34-year old driver from West Carrollton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Two Headlights Required, Fictitious Registration, and Driving Under Suspension.

January 12, 2016 – 1419 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on South Main Street where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry.

January 12, 2015 – 1437 hours

A South East Street resident reported a known person had stolen items from his home, and sold them. The report is under investigation.



January 12, 2016 – 1731 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry to the vehicle.

January 12, 2016 – 2253 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on Ridgeway Road near the intersection of North Main Street that was causing a traffic hazard. Contact was made with the vehicle owner who advised he could not remove the vehicle from its location until the next day. Due to the traffic hazard, the vehicle was towed from the scene.

January 13, 2016 – 1730 hours

A vehicle was stopped on South East Street for a Loud Muffler violation. A young child in the vehicle was not properly restrained. Investigation led to the driver being cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving Under Suspension, No Seatbelt, Fictitious Registration and No Child Restraint. A passenger in the vehicle was wanted on an active warrant from the Madison County Sheriff's Department. The passenger was taken into custody and transferred to Madison County Sheriff's deputies.

January 14, 2016 – 0150 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer located an open garage door on Knob Hill Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who secured the door.

January 14, 2016 – 1026 hours

A resident on Clearview Drive complaint of tree trimmers at her residence who had done damage to her privacy fence. The complainant was advised to contact the contractor performing the work to resolve the issue.



January 15, 2016 – 0155 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old driver from Kettering was intoxicated. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated, Defective Muffler, and No License Plate Light.

January 15, 2016 – 1138 hours

An officer was dispatched to Bledsoe Drive on a barking dog complaint. Contact was made with the canine owner and given a verbal warning.

January 16, 2016 – 1829 hours

Officers responded to a residence on South East Street on the report of an unwanted person. The complainant advised that a subject known to him, had entered his residence without his permission. Formal charges are pending.
