January 17, 2016 – 0157 hours

A theft reportedly occurred on East South Street. The suspect vehicle fled from the scene and was stopped at a business on State Route 725, with the assistance of Sugarcreek Township police officers. Two occupants were taken to the police department for interviews. The 20-year old driver of the vehicle was wanted on an active nationwide warrant from Warren County. The driver had also operated the vehicle without a valid Driver's License. He was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail. A passenger in the vehicle, a 19-year old female from Harveysburg was found in possession of drug paraphernalia. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Possession of Criminal Tools. A second passenger, a 20-year old male from Waynesville who fled on foot was charged with Possession of Criminal Tools and Theft. A warrant was issued for his arrest. The investigation is ongoing.

January 18, 2016 – 1737 hours

An officer observed a suspicious vehicle on Upper Hillside Drive. As the officer turned his cruiser around to start following the vehicle, he noticed that the vehicle was speeding away from him. The vehicle started traveling at a high rate of speed. The vehicle turned onto Ridgeway Road, pulled into a driveway and turned off its' lights. The officer made contact with the driver, a 36-year old female from Dayton who advised that she did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

January 18, 2016 – 2154 hours

A routine registration check revealed that the driver of vehicle did not have a valid driver's license. The officer stopped the vehicle on West Franklin Street. The 22-year old suspect from Dayton was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

January 19, 2016 – 1825 hours

Officers were dispatched to the area of Beechwood Drive and Regent Park on the report of suspicious persons in the area. Officers located the subjects and learned that they were involved in door-to-door sales without a Solicitor's Permit. They were ordered to cease their activity, and issued a warning for Soliciting without a Permit. The subjects left the area.



January 19, 2016 – 2217 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 22-year old driver from West Carrollton did not have a valid driver's license. There was also a fictitious license plate on the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Fictitious Registration, and Defective Muffler.

January 20, 2016 – 2334 hours

A traffic stop on State Route 725 for an equipment violation revealed that the 25-year old driver from Spring Valley did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Failure to Display Vehicle Registration.

January 21, 2016 – 0108 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle near State Route 725 after investigation revealed that the 38-year old driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

January 22, 2016 – 0029 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street for a moving violation. Investigation led to the arrest of the 42-year old driver from Bellbrook for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Failure to Signal Turn. He was released to a relative.

January 22, 2016 – 1035 hours

While on routine patrol an officer found a canine running loose on North Main Street. The officer retrieved the animal which was wearing a collar without a dog tag, and checked the area for any persons searching for the animal. The officer did not locate anyone. The canine was transported to the police department where it was picked up by Animal Control.



January 23, 2016 – 0257 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on South Main Street for a moving violation. The 48-year old driver from Wapakoneta was found to be impaired. An open container of beer and marijuana was located inside the vehicle. The suspect was arrested and charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Open Container, and Improper Turn. A 23-year old passenger from Lima was arrested and charged with Possession of Criminal Tools and Drug Abuse. Both subjects were transported to the Greene County Jail.

January 23, 2016 – 1413 hours

An officer assisted the Bellbrook Fire Department with an odor investigation on Kensington Drive. High levels of natural gas were detected inside the home. All units remained on scene until the utilities company arrived and the gas level reached a safe limit.

January 23, 2016 – 1837 hours

A traffic stop was conducted on Wilmington Pike for Expired Registration. Investigation revealed that the 53-year old driver from Springfield did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Expired Registration.

January 23, 2016 – 1929 hours

Officers were dispatched to Kensington Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. The residence checked secure.
