**January 24, 2016 – 0252 hours**

While on patrol, an officer observed a suspicious vehicle with three occupants on Ryder Court. The officer made contact with the driver, who advised he had just dropped off a friend and were leaving the area.

**January 24, 2016 – 0342 hours**

An officer assisted Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a domestic violence incident on Surrey Trail. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature, and the officer cleared the scene.

**January 24, 2016 – 0857 hours**

A traffic accident was reported on North Belleview Drive. The driver at-fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Yield while making a Left Turn.

**January 25, 2016 – 0210 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment and moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 22-year old driver from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was arrested for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Defective Muffler, and Left of Center. He was released to a relative.

**January 25, 2016 – 1209 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Dane Court on the report of a subject involved in door-to-door sales. Contact was made with the suspect who was advised to cease his activity until he obtained a solicitor's permit.

**January 25, 2016 – 1413 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Sugar Maple Place on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that a baby-sitter accidentally had set off the alarm. Confirmed false alarm.



### **January 25, 2016 – 1450 hours**

A 3-vehicle accident was reported on Upper Bellbrook Road. A vehicle traveling south on Upper Bellbrook Road near Big Tree Road failed to see that two vehicles in front of her were stopped in traffic. The driver at-fault rear ended the vehicle in front of her, pushing it into the rear of the second stopped vehicle. The 18-year old driver from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Assured Clear Distance Ahead.

### **January 26, 2016 – 0829 hours**

Officers responded to Ryder Court on a welfare check after the landlord advised he had not seen his tenant for several days. Contact was made with the tenant, who had been ill, and a Bellbrook Medic was dispatched. Officers also observed evidence of a physical altercation on the tenant. It was learned that she had been a victim of a domestic violence incident that occurred in Beavercreek. The victim was put in contact with the proper authorities and transported to the hospital. It was learned that a second occupant in the home was wanted on an active warrant from the Greene County Sheriff's Department. He was placed into custody and was picked up by a Greene County Sheriff's Deputy.

### **January 27, 2016 – 1715 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street on the report of an intoxicated customer. Investigation led to the arrest of a 60-year old Beavercreek resident for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence. She was released to a relative.

### **January 28, 2016 – 0416 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation on Washington Mill Road. Investigation revealed that the 20-year old driver had an active warrant for his arrest and did not have a valid driver's license. He was arrested and transported to the Greene County Jail. Two passengers in the vehicle were in possession of Criminal Tools and wanted on active warrants. They were also transported to the Greene County Jail. A third passenger in the vehicle was in the possession of marijuana. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.



**January 28, 2016 – 1300 hours**

A business on South Main Street reported receiving a bad check. Contact was attempted with the suspect. The business owner called back later in the day and advised that the suspect had returned to the business and had made proper payment. The report was closed.

**January 28, 2016 – 2301 hours**

Officers were dispatched to South Linda Drive on a welfare check. The complainant advised that the garage door was open at the residence of an elderly female. Contact was made with the resident who was found to be ok, and closed the garage door.

**January 29, 2016 – 1815 hours**

An officer assisted a female who had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**January 30, 2016 – 0112 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 23-year old driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and issued a warning for No Rear License Plate Illumination.

**January 30, 2016 – 0117 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on W Franklin Street for several moving violations. Investigation revealed that the 46-year old driver from Dayton was impaired. He was arrested for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Left of Center, and Failure to Signal Turn. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.



**January 30, 2016 – 2015 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Poston Drive on the report of a domestic dispute. A 16-year old male was arrested for Domestic Violence by Threats and transported to the Greene County Juvenile Detention Center.

**January 30, 2016 – 2356 hours**

An officer was dispatched to North Belleview Drive on the report of water main break causing a traffic hazard. The officer stood by until the Bellbrook Service Department arrived on scene to repair the water main break.
