**January 31, 2016 – 1819 hours**

An officer was dispatched to East Carmella Court on the report of a harassing phone call. Report was taken.

**January 31, 2016 – 1939 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old driver from Bellbrook was impaired. He was arrested for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, and Failure to Stay in Marked Lanes.

**February 1, 2016 – 1332 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Dane Lane. The complainant advised the vehicle had been parked on the street for at least five days. Investigation revealed that the vehicle belongs to a neighbor's relative.

**February 1, 2016 – 1831 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the driver of the vehicle had an active protection order against a subject in the vehicle. The 33-year old passenger from Bellbrook was taken into custody. Further investigation revealed that the suspect was wanted on an active warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office. He was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail.

**February 2, 2016 – 0023 hours**

A found wallet was turned into the police department. Contact was made with the owner, who picked up his property later in the week.



**February 2, 2016 – 0800 hrs**

A subject arrived on post to file a fraud report. The complainant advised that he had purchased a firearm on the internet, and sent a money order to the seller. The “for sale” ad was pulled from another website and was found to be fraudulent. The case was referred to the Woodstock Police Department in Georgia.

**February 2, 2016 – 1723 hours**

A traffic accident was reported in the parking lot of an East Franklin Street business, where a vehicle had backed into a building. Investigation led to the arrest of a 55-year old female from Centerville for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Failure to Control.

**February 2, 2016 – 1730 hours**

A Beechwood Drive resident reported receiving a phone call from a “Bellbrook Trooper” who was asking for a monetary donation. The officer taking the report explained to the complainant that this is a scam call, and that the Bellbrook Police Department is not collecting any donations. The report is under investigation.

**February 2, 2016 – 2008 hours**

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on West Franklin Street. A vehicle rear-ended another vehicle stopped at a red light. The driver at-fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Assured Clear Distance Ahead.

**February 3, 2016 – 0707 hours**

A theft from a vehicle was reported on Weller Drive. The complainant advised that a car stereo and fishing gear had been taken from his vehicle. The report is under investigation.



**February 3, 2016 – 0858 hours**

An officer was dispatched on the report of a traffic hazard on West Franklin Street. Upon arrival, the officer observed a box of nails spilled onto the road. The Bellbrook Service Department was requested to respond to clean up the roadway.

**February 3, 2016 – 1541 hours**

A resident on Weller Drive reported that several electronics had been stolen from her vehicle. The report is under investigation.

**February 3, 2016 – 1921 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer observed a vehicle in the lot of Eagle Land Park after closing hours. Upon making contact with the driver, the officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Investigation led to the 17-year old driver from Miamisburg being cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Drug Abuse and Drug Paraphernalia. A 19-year old passenger from Bellbrook was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse.

**February 5, 2016 – 0331 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer found an open garage door on Bledsoe Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who secured the door.

**February 5, 2016 – 0710 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a registration violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license, and was impaired. The suspect was arrested for Driving under Suspension and Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence.

**February 5, 2016 – 1229 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Hillcrest Drive to assist a resident who had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.



**February 5, 2016 – 1614 hours**

A dispute was reported on South East Street. Investigation resulted in a 33-year old male from Xenia being cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Disorderly Conduct.

**February 5, 2016 – 1726 hours**

A resident on Eckworth Drive filed a Fraud report. The complainant advised that an unknown subject had made a purchase of over \$3,600.00, in her name. The complainant advised she became aware of the fraud when she was contacted by a collection agency. The report has been assigned to a detective.

**February 6, 2016 – 0018 hours**

Officers responded to Moss Oak Trail on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. The parties separated for the evening.

**February 6, 2016 – 1245 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for expired registration. Investigation revealed that the 39-year old driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Expired Registration.
