February 7, 2016 – 0010 hours

An officer was dispatched to Moss Oak Trail on the report of a barking dog. Contact was made with the owner, who was told to take the animal inside.

February 7, 2016 – 0630 hours

An officer attempted to stop a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. The vehicle accelerated and while attempting to flee from the officer it crashed into a vehicle parked on Mill Pond Drive. Three occupants fled the vehicle on foot. Investigation revealed that the vehicle was stolen from Dayton, and contained stolen property from Bellbrook, Greene County, Xenia, and Harrison Township. Two of the suspects were apprehended not with the assistance of a Greene County Canine Officer. The driver of the stolen vehicle, an 18-year old male from Dayton was charged with Receiving Stolen Property, Obstructing Official Business, Failure to Control, Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Allow Unlicensed Driver to Operate, and Lights Required on Roadway. A 17-year old passenger from Dayton was charged with Receiving Stolen Property, Obstructing Official Business, Failure to Comply with an Order of Police, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Underage Consumption. The third suspect, an 18-year old male from Dayton was apprehended the next day and charged with Receiving Stolen Property and Obstructing Official Business. All suspects were incarcerated.

February 8, 2016 – 1132 hours

An officer assisted a subject on North East Street who had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

February 8, 2016 – 2110 hours

An officer assisted a female who had locked her keys in her vehicle parked in a State Route 725 business lot. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.



February 9, 2016 – 1048 hours

A subject locked his keys in his vehicle at his home on Hillcrest Drive. An officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

February 9, 2016 – 1318 hours

A Hillcrest Drive resident reported that while filing his tax return, he was notified that someone had already filed his taxes by using his Social Security Number. The case was referred to the IRS office in Dayton.

February 9, 2016 – 1950 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Possum Run Road. A 17-year old female from Bellbrook was traveling Eastbound on Possum Run Road and attempted to make a turn onto Fowler Drive, but lost control of the vehicle and struck a tree. The driver was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Control.

February 10, 2016 – 1804 hours

Officers assisted a subject whose vehicle had slipped off the roadway on Ryder Court. A tow truck was called to remove the vehicle.

February 11, 2016 – 0035 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle traveling on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old driver from Xenia was in possession of Marijuana. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for the drug violation and Shortcutting across Private Property.

February 11, 2016 – 0216 hours

A vehicle was stopped on South Belleview Drive for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 32-year old driver from Middletown did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Defective Muffler.



February 11, 2016 – 0300 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 37-year old driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

February 11, 2016 – 0937 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on W Franklin Street. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. All parties involved were separated.

February 11, 2016 – 1201 hours

A Moss Oak Trail resident reported receiving a letter and check advising he had won second place in a sweepstakes. The letter stated that he needed to send \$3,600.00 dollars in for a processing fee. The officer taking the report explained to the complainant that it is a known scam, and to destroy the check.

February 12, 2016 – 1225 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sugar Maple Place on a burglary alarm activation. The home was checked and found to be ok. Confirmed false alarm.

February 12, 2016 – 1403 hours

An officer was dispatched to the intersection of Feedwire and Clys Road to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a traffic crash. The officer conducted traffic control until no longer needed.

February 12, 2016 – 2000 hours

A Justin Court resident reported that he received a notification from his bank that someone had attempted to use his credit card number at three different locations in Brooklyn, New York. The complainant's account was closed.



February 12, 2016 – 2109 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 56-year old driver from Spring Valley was impaired. He was arrested for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Left of Center.

February 13, 2016 – 0129 hours

A traffic stop on West Franklin Street for a moving violation revealed that the 25-year old driver from Dayton was impaired. The suspect was arrested for Operating a Vehicle while Intoxicated and Left of Center, and transported to the Greene County Jail.

February 13, 2016 – 1311 hours

An officer observed a 50-year old female from Centerville driving her vehicle after being arrested for OVI weeks earlier. The officer stopped the vehicle because the suspect's driver's license was now suspended. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and her vehicle was towed.
