February 14, 2016 – 2119 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

February 14, 2016 – 2240 hours

A traffic stop on State Route 725 for a registration violation revealed that the 24-year old driver from Kettering was impaired. The suspect was arrested and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Display of Vehicle Registration.

February 15, 2016 – 0848 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with traffic control after an accident occurred on State Route 725 near Penewit Road.

February 15, 2016 – 1710 hours

A resident on Beryl Drive reported that a television was delivered at his home, but that he did not make the purchase. Immediately after the delivery, an unknown male subject arrived at his home claiming the television was his, because he had the tracking number of the package. The complainant told the male subject he was calling the police and the suspect left the area. The complainant called the company where the television had come from, and was told that someone had opened a line of credit in his name by using his Social Security number. The television was shipped back to the company. The complainant notified all credit bureaus of the fraud.

February 15, 2016 – 1741 hours

An officer was dispatched to the area of Little Sugarcreek Road and Vineyards Way on the report of an unoccupied vehicle in the roadway. The officer located the driver of the vehicle walking with a fuel can on Little Sugarcreek Road. The officer offered the subject a ride back to his vehicle.



Investigation revealed that 52-year old driver from Middletown did not have a valid driver's license and was wanted on a warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. The suspect was taken into custody. An open can of an alcoholic beverage was located inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited for Driving under Suspension and Open Container. He was transported to the Greene County Jail to await a transfer to the Montgomery County Jail.

February 17, 2016 – 0057 hours

An officer was dispatched on the report of loud noises coming from a State Route 725 business. The officer checked the business and located a cleaning crew working at the building.

February 17, 2016 – 0230 hours

While on routine patrol on Washington Mill Road, an officer observed a 14-year old male from Sugarcreek Township out past curfew. The juvenile was transported back to his residence and contact was made with his parent. Investigation revealed that the juvenile is currently on probation through Greene County, and that the curfew violation was also a violation of his probation. Later in the day, the juvenile was picked up by his probation officer and transported to the Greene County Juvenile Detention Center to be incarcerated.

February 17, 2016 – 1458 hours

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle at the intersection of North East Street and East Franklin Street. The vehicle was moved from the roadway into a parking lot. The vehicle was secured and later towed.

February 18, 2016 – 0630 hours

While on routine patrol an officer found an open window at a vacant home. Upon further investigation a back door to the home was also found open. A 36-year old female friend of the family was found asleep inside the home. Contact was made with the homeowner who wanted the female from Middletown trespassed from the property.



February 18, 2016 – 1702 hours

A resident on Ridgeway Road advised that unknown subject(s) had opened several business accounts in his name by using his Social Security number, and that fraudulent charges were made on those accounts. The complainant advised he had also received income tax forms for the accounts. The complainant was given advice to protect his identity in the future. The case was referred to the Internal Revenue Service for investigation.

February 18, 2016 – 1953 hours

A traffic stop on Wilmington-Dayton Road revealed that the 25-year old driver from Lebanon did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

February 19, 2016 – 0900 hours

Investigation of suspicious activity at a vacant home led to the arrest of a 34-year old male from Xenia for Receiving Stolen Property, Possessing Criminal Tools, and Disorderly Conduct. A 22-year old male from Clarksville was arrested for Possessing Criminal Tools and Drug Abuse. A third suspect, a 27-year old female from Xenia was arrested for Possessing Criminal Tools and Drug Abuse.

February 19, 2016 – 1719 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on South East Street for Two Brake Lights Required. Investigation led to the 18-year old driver from Dayton being cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Possessing Criminal Tools.

February 20, 2016 – 0342 hours

A traffic stop for a Speed violation on West Franklin Street revealed that the 23-year old driver from Xenia was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Speed.



February 20, 2016 – 1419 hours

A resident on Hillcrest Drive reported that a subject known to him had stolen money and checks from him. The case is under investigation.

February 20, 2016 – 2234 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road. Investigation revealed that the 26-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.
