**February 21, 2016 – 1410 hours**

Officers were dispatched to East Maple Street for a domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature.

**February 21, 2016 – 1933 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Wilmington-Dayton Road on the report of a disabled vehicle in the roadway. The officer and vehicle owner were able to move the vehicle off the roadway.

**February 22, 2016 – 1450 hours**

An officer took a report of a traffic violation involving a school bus. A 39-year old female from Bellbrook had passed a school bus while it was stopped to drop off children. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.

**February 21, 2016 – 1547 hours**

A 23-year old male from Bellbrook passed a school bus while it was stopped to drop off children on West Franklin Street. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court.

**February 22, 2016 – 2029 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Maple Leaf Court on the report of a 27-year old male subject yelling at his neighbors. The suspect was ordered to stop his actions.

**February 24, 2016 – 0328 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Red Rock Court on the report of a 9-1-1 hang up. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised there was no emergency, and was experiencing problems with his telephone.



**February 24, 2016 – 0708 hours**

A resident on Chelsea Drive reported that unknown subject(s) had gone through her unlocked vehicle and stolen her purse and 3 checkbooks. The report is under investigation.

**February 24, 2016 – 1726 hours**

A resident on Periwinkle Drive reported she received a call from someone who claimed to be working for the United States Treasure Department. The caller told the complainant that she had an active warrant out for her arrest. The complainant was then asked for her personal information such as her Social Security number. The officer explained to the complainant that this is a known scam and she was given advice about protecting her identity in the future.

**February 26, 2016 – 0233 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment and moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 36-year old driver from Fairfield did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Court for Driving under Suspension and issued a warning for No Front License Plate.

**February 26, 2016 – 1450 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 20-year old driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Failure to Obey a Traffic Control Device.

**February 26, 2016 – 1811 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Shore Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival, officers found an unlocked back door. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised that she had forgotten to lock the door. The interior of the house was checked and found to be ok.



**February 26, 2016 – 2028 hours**

Loud music was reported on Lynlee Drive. Upon arrival the officer made contact with the homeowner and advised him of the complaint.

**February 27, 2016 – 0025 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Hillcrest Drive on a Loud Music complaint. Contact was made with the responsible party, who turned off the music.

Officers were dispatched on the report of an open front door at a home on East Franklin Street. Contact was made with the owner. The home was checked and found to be ok. Officers re-secured the home.
