**February 28, 2016 – 0324 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Further investigation led to the arrest of the 21-year old passenger from Xenia for Drug Abuse, Drug Paraphernalia and Criminal Tools. The driver was given a warning for Two Break Lights Required. The vehicle was stopped the following day which resulted in the arrest of the same 20-year old driver from Xenia for Drug Abuse and Drug Paraphernalia.

**February 29, 2016 – 0800 hours**

Criminal Damaging was reported on South East Street. The complainant reported that a lock on a gate leading to his residence was pried open. The residence was checked and found secure without damage or any property stolen.

**February 29, 2016 – 1732 hours**

An officer was flagged down by a pedestrian on Ridgeway Road who informed him that he had found a set of keys hanging on a mailbox door. With assistance of the Post Master, the owner was located, and the keys were returned.

**March 1, 2016 – 0709 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Vin De Rogers Way on the report of a panic alarm activation. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised that his daughter had accidentally entered the wrong security code resulting in the alarm activation.

**March 1, 2016 – 1234 hours**

Officers were requested to assist the Greene County Children Service Bureau with a welfare check on Ryder Court, after they had been unable to make contact with two residents. Contact was made with the assistance of the landlord, and both subjects were found to be ok.



### **March 1, 2016 – 1847 hours**

Officers were dispatched on the report of an alarm activation on North Main Street. Upon arrival, officers found a door to the building standing open. The interior was checked and found to be ok. Contact was made with a key holder who responded and re-secured the door.

### **March 1, 2016 – 2328 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Ryder Court on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature and no physical violence had occurred. Both parties involved were talked to and able to resolve the dispute.

### **March 2, 2016 – 1300 hours**

A boy's bicycle was found at a business on West Franklin Street. The bicycle was taken to the police department and may be claimed by the owner after proper identification.

### **March 3, 2016 – 0238 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located an unlicensed vehicle on South Main Street. Contact was made with the vehicle owner who was given a 10-day notice to remove the vehicle, or get proper registration for the vehicle.

### **March 3, 2016 – 1043 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Pinegrove Drive on the report of a suspicious vehicle traveling through the area. The vehicle was located and the officer made contact with the driver. The driver advised that he was performing tree trimming services and was looking for other business. The officer advised him of the City's soliciting ordinance and to cease his activity.

### **March 3, 2016 – 1122 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located a disabled vehicle on Little Sugarcreek Road. The driver advised that the vehicle had run out of gas, and that a relative was on the way. The officer stood by until the vehicle was moved.



**March 3, 2016 - 1704 hours**

An anonymous call was received that a person, wanted on an active warrant from the Greene County Sheriff's Department was at a business on East Franklin Street. Officers responded to the location where they located the 37-year old suspect. He was taken into custody and transferred to a Greene County Sheriff's Deputy.

**March 4, 2016 – 0647 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 27-year old driver from Dayton was under seven driver's license suspensions. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Display of Vehicle Registration.

**March 4, 2016 – 0850 hours**

Telephone harassment was reported by an employee of a West Franklin Street business. The complainant was given advice about what action to take if she receives any further calls.

**March 4, 2016 – 0147 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for two equipment violations. Investigation revealed that the 22-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, Expired Registration, and Window Tint.

**March 4, 2016 – 0746 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Possum Run Road. Investigation revealed that the vehicle belonged to a resident of a nearby street.

**March 5, 2016 – 2005 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Sugarcreek Drive on an alarm activation. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised that he accidentally had set off the alarm.
