**March 6, 2016 – 2311 hours**

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street on a burglary alarm activation. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised she had accidentally set off the alarm.

**March 7, 2016 – 0317 hours**

Officers found an open door to a business on West Franklin Street. Contact was made with the business owner. The building was checked and found to be ok. The door was re-secured.

**March 7, 2017 -1915 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street. Investigation revealed that the 20-year old female driver did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**March 7, 2017 – 2140 hours**

A traffic stop on Wilmington-Dayton Road revealed that the 45-year old driver from Sugarcreek Township did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**March 8, 2016 – 1729 hours**

A traffic stop on East Franklin Street revealed that the 33-year old driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**March 8, 2016 – 1936 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Sugar Run Trail on the report of a suspicious vehicle. Upon arrival the officer located the vehicle and made contact with the driver. The driver advised he was talking to a friend who resides in the area.



### **March 8, 2016 -2119 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer located a vehicle at McGee Park. Contact was made with the driver, who was advised that the park was closed and to leave the area.

### **March 8, 2016 – 2316 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington Pike for an equipment violation. During the stop officers located marijuana which led to charges filed against the 33-year old male from Sugarcreek Township for Drug Abuse.

### **March 9, 2016 - 0943 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Ryder Court on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature and no physical violence had taken place.

### **March 9, 2016 – 1057 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Ridgetop Drive for a welfare check. The complainant from Union, Ohio advised that he had been unable to reach his mother by phone for 5 days. Upon arrival the officer made contact with the homeowner who was advised to call her son to let him know she is okay.

### **March 9, 2016 – 1456 hours**

A building owner on East Franklin Street reported that a neighbor was illegally using his dumpster to throw away construction materials. The neighbor was spoken to, and ordered to remove all his trash from the dumpster.

### **March 9, 2016 – 1631 hours**

A resident on Poston Drive reported two unwanted subjects on his property. A 47-year old female and a 16-year old female, both from Bellbrook, were issued warnings for Criminal Trespassing and ordered not to return to the address on Poston Drive.



**March 10, 2016 – 1425 hours**

A vehicle off the roadway was reported on Washington Mill Road. With the assistance of the driver and a passerby the vehicle was pulled from the easement and back onto the roadway.

**March 10, 2016 – 1542 hours**

An officer responded to a business on West Franklin Street where a subject had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**March 10, 2016 – 1603 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Chelsea Drive where a resident found a sliding glass door of her home standing open. There was no evidence that the door had been tampered with. The interior of the home was checked and nothing appeared to be missing.

**March 10, 2016 – 1933 hours**

A 53-year old male reported a being a victim of a road rage incident that occurred on Bigger Road in Centerville. The victim advised pulling into the parking lot of a State Route 725 business. The suspect followed the victim into the parking lot and assaulted him. The case has been assigned to a detective.

**March 11, 2016 – 0043 hours**

Officers located a subject wanted on an active warrant from the Centerville Police Department at a business on State Route 725. The 33-year male from Centerville was taken into custody and turned over to the Centerville Police Department.



**March 12, 2016 – 0427 hours**

A vehicle was stopped on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old driver from Xenia did not have a driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for No Operator's License and Defective Muffler. Further investigation revealed that a 20-year old passenger from Xenia had consumed alcohol. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Underage Consumption.

**March 12, 2016 – 1101 hours**

A subject involved in door-to-door sales was reported on Moss Oak Trail. The subject was located and it was learned he did not have a soliciting permit. The officer explained the City's ordinance for soliciting in Bellbrook and ordered the subject to cease his activity.

**March 12, 2016 – 1202 hours**

A traffic stop was made on Wilmington Pike. Investigation revealed that the 33-year old driver from Centerville did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**March 12, 2016 – 2305 hours**

Officers were dispatched to South Linda Drive on the report of a domestic dispute. Investigation led to the arrest of a 36-year old male resident for Domestic Violence and Assault. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.
