March 13, 2016 – 0708 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer observed a suspicious person on foot on North Belleview Drive. Contact was made with the subject and investigation revealed that the subject was wanted on an active warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office. The 22-year old male from Bellbrook was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

March 13, 2016 – 1055 hours

An officer located a disabled vehicle on North Main Street. A tow truck was called and the officer stood by until the vehicle was removed from the roadway.

March 13, 2016 – 1513 hours

An officer was dispatched on an intrusion alarm activation on West Franklin Street. The homeowner advised she had accidentally set off the alarm.

March 14, 2016 – 0207 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle at the intersection of Main Street and Franklin Street. The 33-year old female driver from Bellbrook was wanted on a warrant from Miami Township Police Department. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.

March 14, 2016 – 0421 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with an OVI arrest. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

March 14, 2016 – 0937 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for speeding. Investigation revealed that the 26-year old female from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Speed.



March 15, 2016 – 0844 hours

A resident on Beryl Drive reported that he had locked his keys in his vehicle. An officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

March 17, 2016 – 0721 hours

A routine vehicle registration check on South Main Street revealed that the 33-year old driver from Spring Valley did not have a valid driver's license. The officer stopped the vehicle and issued the suspect a citation for Driving under Suspension.

March 18, 2016 – 0220 hours

An officer located a suspicious person on foot on State Route 725. It was learned that the 17-year old male was walking from Sugarcreek Township to his residence in Centerville. The officer gave the subject a ride home.

March 18, 2016 – 1234 hours

A resident on Plantation Trail reported being involved in a dispute with two delivery persons. The report is under investigation.

March 18, 2016 – 1304 hours

A complaint was received of subjects involved in door-to-door sales on Beryl drive. An officer located three subjects and they were advised of the City's soliciting ordinance. A written warning was issued to the supervisor of the company, and all subjects were ordered to cease their activity.

March 18, 2016 – 1348 hours

A resident on McHenry Court reported receiving a threatening e-mail from an unknown subject. The e-mailed appeared to have been originated in a foreign country. Extra patrol of the home was initiated.



March 18, 2016 – 1705 hours

A resident on Eckworth Drive reported that someone had created a social media account in her name. The complainant advised that this was the third time this had happened to her, and requested the perpetrator to be criminally charged. The case has been assigned to a detective.

March 19, 2016 -2243 hours

An officer observed a vehicle traveling on Wilmington-Dayton Road without a license plate light. The officer stopped the vehicle on Whites Corner Drive. Upon contact the officer smelled an odor of marijuana. The 25-year old Bellbrook resident turned over the marijuana to the officer. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and a No Seatbelt violation, and given a warning for No Rear License Plate Light.

March 19, 2016 – 2343 hours

A resident on Cabernet Way reported hearing knocking sounds coming from his garage. Officers checked the garage but did not hear or see anything. The complainant was advised to call back if there were any further problems.
