**March 20, 2016 – 0159 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 23-year old female driver from Wilmington did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and given a warning for Failure to Dim.

**March 20, 2016 – 0338 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a moving violation. Investigation revealed that the 46-year old male driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and given a warning for No Turn Signal.

**March 20, 2016 -1918 hours**

A vehicle was stopped on East Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 33-year old male driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Defective Muffler.

**March 20, 2016 – 2042 hours**

An officer was dispatched to North Field Drive on the report of a suspicious vehicle. The officer located the vehicle and made contact with the occupants who advised they were looking at homes for sale in the area.

**March 21, 2016 – 1717 hours**

A female from Middletown advised she had locked her keys in her vehicle parked at a business on State Route 725. An officer was able gain entry into the vehicle.



**March 22, 2016 – 0526 hours**

A juvenile residing on Poston Drive reported being in a domestic dispute with his parents and being locked out of his home. Investigation revealed that the juvenile had lied about the whole incident and that no domestic dispute had occurred. The 16-year old suspect was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Falsification.

**March 22, 2016 – 1255 hours**

A resident on North Sheffield Drive reported that unknown subject(s) had made fraudulent charges on a company credit card. The case was assigned to a detective.

**March 22, 2016 – 1926 hours**

A complaint was received of a resident on Creekview Place who jogs in the area with her dog, without having the animal on a leash. The Bellbrook leash law was explained to the suspect.

**March 23, 2016 – 0014 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Callaway Court. Contact was made with the driver of the vehicle who advised he had just arrived home and was talking to his friends in the car before going inside his house.

**March 23, 2016 -0809 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Hillrise Circle on the report of a sick raccoon. The officer located the animal and disposed of it.

**March 23, 2016 – 1732 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Locus Bend Drive on the report of suspicious persons knocking on and opening doors. Officers located the subjects who advised they were involved in door-to-door sales. They denied opening any doors. The subjects were advised of the Bellbrook Soliciting Ordinance and ordered to cease their activity.



**March 24, 2016 – 0936 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Knoll Drive on the report of a suspicious vehicle driving very slowly through the area. The vehicle was located by a Sugarcreek Township Police Officer and it was learned that the driver was delivering newspapers.

**March 24, 2016 – 1408 hours**

While on routine patrol an officer observed a tree fall across the roadway on East South Street. The windshield of a vehicle parked behind it was damaged. The officer took a report and remained on scene until the tree was removed from the roadway.

**March 24, 2016 – 1507 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Brewsters Run Court on an intrusion alarm activation. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised she was experiencing problems with the alarm system. The homeowner was told to contact the alarm company.

**March 24, 2016 – 1911 hours**

A subject on North Main Street reported locking his keys in his vehicle. An officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

**March 25, 2016 – 0524 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Beechwood Drive on a barking dog complaint. Contact was made with the owner who was given a warning.

**March 25, 2016 – 0525 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Walnut Street. Investigation revealed that the 23-year old driver from Riverside did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.



### **March 25, 2016 – 0630 hours**

Reports of unlocked vehicles entered and items taken were received from Lynlee Drive, Sandstone Court, Justin Court, Possum Run Road, and Fowler Drive. While investigating, officers located a subject riding a bicycle and ordered him to stop. The subject gave chase, dropping the bicycle, and a backpack. A foot pursuit through mostly wooded areas ended near San Souci. Officers searched the area with the assistance of Sugarcreek Township Police Department but were unable to locate the subject. The bicycle and items from the backpack that had been taken from the vehicles were returned to the rightful owners.

### **March 25, 2016 - 0830 hours**

A private property accident was reported on West Franklin Street. Insurance information was exchanged.

### **March 25, 2016 – 1002 hours**

A resident on East Franklin Street reported finding a Patriot Bond that belongs to a person living in Connecticut. The bond was turned over to the police department and the owner was reached out to.

Officers were dispatched to Rosecrest Drive on the report of a possible burglary in progress. The complainant reported seeing a male subject climbing into the home through a window. Investigation revealed that the subject lives at the residence and that there was no problem.

A physical altercation was reported on West Franklin Street. Investigation led to charges filed against a 16-year old juvenile from Bellbrook for Assault.

While on routine patrol, an officer located an open garage door on Bledsoe Drive. Contact was made with the homeowner who checked the garage before closing the door.
