**October 2, 2016 – 1730 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Ryder Court on the report of an illegally parked vehicle. Contact was made with the owner who moved the vehicle.

**October 2, 2016 – 2313 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street on an alarm activation. The building was found secure, without any signs of criminal activity.

**October 3, 2016 – 2300 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Washington Mill Road on the report of a possible burglary in progress. The complainant advised that someone was trying to get into her house through the back door. Upon the officers' arrival, no one was located. There was however a possum on the roof, possibly responsible for the earlier noises at the back door.

**October 4, 2016 – 0631 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street for an equipment violation. The 31-year old driver from Bellbrook was found to be under the influence of marijuana and taken into custody. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, and No License Plate Light.

**October 4, 2016 – 1041 hours**

An inoperable vehicle on jack stands was located in a driveway on Sandstone Court. The owner of the vehicle was issued a 10-day warning letter remove the vehicle from the driveway.

**October 4, 2016 – 1923 hours**

A juvenile reported that a subject on Lower Hillside Drive had yelled racial slurs to her while walking past the suspect's resident. Contact was made with the suspect who denied the allegation. The juvenile was advised to contact the police department should she have any further problems with the suspect.



**October 5, 2016 – 0909 hours**

A suspicious person was reported at a business on West Franklin Street. Contact was made with the subject in question, who advised he was there waiting to be picked up by his employer. Moments later the employer arrived and the subjects left the area.

**October 5, 2016 – 1730 hours**

An officer responded to Tennyson Drive where two dogs were found. The complainant knew who the dogs belong to, but had been unable to make contact with him. The officer made contact with the owner who took control of the animals.

**October 5, 2016 – 1854 hours**

Loud music was reported on Tampico Trail. Upon the officer's arrival he located a band practicing in a garage. The subjects were advised of the complaint and to lower the music volume.

**October 5, 2016 – 2116 hours**

A routine registration check of a vehicle traveling on East Franklin Street revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The 27-year old female driver from Spring Valley was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**October 5, 2016 – 2221 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a Speed violation. Investigation revealed that the 28-year old male driver from Kettering did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Speed.

**October 6, 2016 -0200 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. The 35-year old female driver from Franklin lied twice to the officer about her identity, by using the



Social Security numbers of two different females. After refusing to be truthful and revealing her identity to the officer she was taken into custody. The female finally told the officer her true identity, which revealed that she did not have a valid driver's license and was wanted on four warrants for her arrest from various local agencies. An uncapped drug syringe was found inside of the vehicle. The suspect was charged with Falsification, Obstruction of Justice, Possession of Criminal Tools, Driving under Suspension, and No License Plate light. She was transported to the Greene County Jail. The vehicle was towed. On October 8<sup>th</sup>, the owner of the vehicle called the arresting officer and advised him that the suspect had taken the keys to her vehicle in Butler Township and had given the victim a false name. She had later found out the suspect's real name and learned that she was incarcerated at the Greene County Jail. A report was filed with the Butler Township Police Department and the suspect was served an additional charge for Receiving Stolen Property. The victim was able to retrieve her vehicle from the tow lot.

#### **October 6, 2016 – 0430 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a vehicle registration violation. Investigation revealed that the registration on the vehicle was fictitious and that the 46-year old driver from Kettering was impaired. The suspect was arrested for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Fictitious Registration, and Expired Registration.

#### **October 6, 2016 – 1515 hours**

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on North Main Street. The driver at-fault had struck the rear of a stopped vehicle. The 16-year old male from Bellbrook was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Failure to Assure Clear Distance Ahead.

#### **October 7, 2016 – 1945 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 on the report of an intoxicated subject who refused to pay for his bill. Upon contact with the 57-year old suspect from Xenia, the officers told him to pay his bill and have a family member pick him up or he would be taken into custody. The suspect paid his bill and had his son pick him up.



**October 7, 2016 – 2154 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Jacob Hills Court on the report of a suspicious vehicle parked near a home under construction. Investigation revealed that a worker had left the vehicle there for the night.

**October 8, 2016 – 0855 hours**

A vehicle was stopped on North Main Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 58-year old driver from Beavercreek did not have a valid driver's license and he was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**October 8, 2016 – 2119 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on the report of an intrusion alarm activation. Investigation revealed that the alarm had accidentally been set off by a caretaker.
