October 23, 2016 – 0349 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a speed violation. Investigation revealed that the 27-year old female from Bellbrook was impaired. Two drug pipes were located inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Speed. Additional drug charges are pending laboratory results. A 34-year old male passenger from Dayton, who had been arrested on a drug charge 3 days prior, was found to be in the possession of a drug scale. He was charged with Possession of Criminal Tools and transported to the Greene County Jail.

October 23, 2016 – 1259 hours

A resident on Moss Oak Trail reported that two political signs had been stolen from his yard.

October 24, 2016 – 0121 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Main Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 31-year old female driver from Dayton was impaired, and did not have a valid driver's license. Two drug needles were found in the suspect's possession along with drugs. The suspect was charged with Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Driving under Suspension, Possession of Criminal Tools, and Cracked Windshield. The female was transported to the Greene County Jail. Additional drug charges are pending laboratory results.

October 24, 2016 – 1258 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving a bad check. The report is under investigation.

October 25, 2016 – 1424 hours

Officers were dispatched to Bledsoe Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival, the homeowner advised he had accidentally set off the alarm.



October 25, 2016 – 1556 hours

A resident on Beryl Drive reported that two credit card accounts had been opened in his name by unknown subject(s) but had not suffered a monetary loss. The complainant was given advice to protect himself from future identity theft.

October 25, 2016 – 1756 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 70-year old female driver from Spring Valley did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and No Front License Plate.

October 25, 2016 – 1837 hours

An officer was dispatched to Maxwell Drive where a dog was reportedly running loose in the area. The officer was able to catch the canine that did not have a collar or tags. The officer was in route to the Greene County Animal Shelter with the dog when the owner showed up at the Police Department. The officer returned to the City and met with the owner, who was issued a written warning for Dog at Large.

October 25, 2016 – 2208 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on North Belleview Drive after having observed it swerve into the oncoming lane of travel several times. While talking to the 19-year old driver from Beavercreek, the officer observed drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. A further search of the vehicle resulted in the officer finding a bag of marijuana inside the glove box. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Failure to Stay in Marked Lanes.



October 26, 2016 – 1656 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the 34-year old male driver from Centerville did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

October 27, 2016 – 0255 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 37-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Failure to File for Annual Vehicle Registration. The suspect was released to a relative.

October 27, 2016 – 1000 hours

A resident on Lakeview Drive reported that someone had stolen and cashed some of his checks. The complainant's credit card was also used recently. The case was assigned to a detective.

October 27, 2016 – 1706 hours

A parking problem was reported on Ryder Court where a trailer was parked on the public roadway. Contact was made with the owner, who moved the trailer to private property.

October 28, 2016 – 1629 hours

A dog bite was reported on Hess Road. While visiting with a friend, a 15-year old female was bitten by the family's dog. A quarantine notice was issued to the dog owner.

October 29, 2016 – 0012 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on East Franklin Street for driving without headlights on. The driver, identified as a 16-year old male from Bellbrook advised that he was on his way to Spring Valley to pick up a friend. He told the officer that he did not have a driver's license. He had taken the vehicle from a relative without permission.



The suspect was cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Driving without a License, Driving without Headlights, and Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle. The vehicle was returned to the owner.

October 29, 2016 – 0245 hours

An officer responded to Wilmington Pike to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a fight at a business. The suspect was reportedly also seen drinking and driving in the parking lot of the business. The officer located the vehicle and made contact with the driver and passengers. A large number of open beer containers were located inside the vehicle. The suspect, a 27-year old male from Miamisburg was taken into custody for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, and Open Container. The passengers were released.

October 29, 2016 – 0922 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on State Route 725 where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

October 29, 2016 – 1030 hours

Criminal Mischief was reported on Kensington Drive where two political signs had been pulled from the ground and were thrown. The signs were undamaged and the owner placed them back in his yard.

October 29, 2016 – 1121 hours

A private property hit & run accident was reported at Bellbrook Plaza. The driver at-fault was located, who advised she did not realize she had backed into a vehicle. Insurance information was exchanged and a report taken.



October 29, 2016 – 2247 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer located some persons at Magee Park after dark. The subjects told the officer they were looking for ghosts. They were advised of the park hours and told to leave the area.
