November 6, 2016 – 0137 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for two moving violations. Investigation revealed that the 54-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired. He was found in possession of prescription medication that did not belong to him. The suspect was charged with Drug Abuse, Driving while under the Influence, Failure to Dim Headlights, and Failure to Use Turn Signals. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

November 7, 2016 – 0215 hours

A traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street near Firebird Drive. A 24-year old male from Kettering had lost control of his vehicle and struck a privacy fence. The suspect was found to be impaired due to prescription medication. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence and Failure to Control.

November 7, 2016 – 1703 hours

A school bus driver reported a violation that had occurred on Firebird Drive when the school bus was stopped to receive a student, and a vehicle passed the bus. The suspect, a 51-year female from Bellbrook admitted that she had driven past the school bus to get into her driveway. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Stop for a School Bus.

November 8, 2016 – 1220 hours

A resident on Whites Drive reported that a door to a neighbor's shed was open. Contact was made with the homeowner who advised that he had accidentally left the door open. Nothing appeared to have been taken from the shed.



November 8, 2016 – 1708 hours

An officer was dispatched to North Lakeman Drive to assist the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a large fight in progress. Several juveniles were cited into Court for Disorderly Conduct. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

November 8, 2016 – 2126 hours

An officer was dispatched to a business on East Franklin Street for found property. Upon arrival an employee turned over a purse containing a driver's license, several credit cards, and cash. The owner was located, and the property was picked up the next day.

November 10, 2016 – 1000 hours

A set of keys was found on Little Sugarcreek Road near West Franklin Street. A Bellbrook Library card was attached to the key ring. Library personnel were able to provide an address for the owner who lives on Sugar Run Trail. The keys were returned to the owner.

November 10, 2016 – 2008 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Investigation revealed that it had been set off accidentally.

November 11, 2016 – 0542 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 43-year old male driver from Xenia did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and was given a warning for Defective Muffler.

November 11, 2016 – 1926 hours

A vehicle was stopped on State Route 725 after it swerved into oncoming traffic several times. Investigation revealed that the 49-year old female driver from Dayton was impaired. An open container of an alcoholic beverage was located inside the vehicle. The suspect was cited into



Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Open Container, and Lane of Travel upon Roadway. She was later released to a relative.

November 12, 2016 – 1036 hours

Officers were dispatched to Barnett Drive on the report of a disturbance. Investigation led to the arrest of a 21-year old male for Assault and Aggravated Menacing. He was transported to the Greene County Jail.

November 12, 2016 – 1459 hours

Officers were dispatched to Woodacre Drive on the report of a residential alarm activation. Upon arrival the officers found an open front door and the homeowner laying on the living room floor. The subject had fallen and was experiencing a medical emergency. The subject was transported to the hospital.

November 12, 2016 – 1758 hours

A vehicle was stopped on State Route 725 for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 41-year old male driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and No License Plate Light.
