**November 13, 2016 – 0349 hours**

A traffic accident was reported in the parking lot of a business on State Route 725 where a car had struck a planter. The driver, a 26-year old female from Kettering was found to be impaired. She did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Driving under Suspension, and Failure to Control. She was released to a relative.

**November 14, 2016 – 1727 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 for a burglary alarm activation. The officers checked the exterior of the business and found no signs of criminal activity.

**November 15, 2016 – 0216 hours**

A burglary alarm activation was reported at a business on East Franklin Street. The exterior of the building checked secure and there were no signs of criminal activity.

**November 15, 2016 – 0734 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Upper Bellbrook Road on the report of a suspicious occupied vehicle that had been parked for several hours. Upon arrival, contact was made with the driver, who advised he had fallen asleep. The subject was told to leave the area which he did without any further problems.

**November 15, 2016 – 1713 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Woodacre Drive on a 9-1-1 hang-up call. Upon the officers' arrival, they found that the homeowner was experiencing a medical issue. A medic transported the subject to the hospital.

**November 15, 2016 – 1731 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Kensington Drive on the report of a dead raccoon in the roadway. The Bellbrook Service Department was notified to dispose of the animal.



**November 15, 2016 – 2000 hours**

A subject on Beryl Drive reported he had locked his keys in his vehicle. An officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

**November 16, 2016 – 0830 hours**

A 9-1-1- hang-up call was received from a business at Bellbrook Plaza. Contact was made with an employee who had no explanation for the call. The business area was checked and nothing was found to be out of order.

**November 16, 2016 – 1736 hours**

Officers were dispatched to the area of Wilmington-Dayton Road near Moss Oak Trail on the report of a fire. Upon arrival, the officers could smell smoke and found a recreational fire in the backyard of a residence on Wilmington-Dayton Road. Officers located a 26-year old male from Dayton working on his vehicle in the driveway of the home. He was ordered to extinguish the fire. Further investigation revealed that the suspect was in possession of marijuana and a drug pipe, and had just smoked marijuana prior the officers' arrival. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Drug Abuse and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**November 17, 2016 – 0449 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on North East Street for a panic alarm activation. Investigation revealed that an employee had accidentally set off the alarm.

**November 17, 2016 – 1154 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street after a routine registration check revealed that the driver, an 18-year old male from Waynesville, did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, and Driving under a Drug Offense Suspension.



**November 18, 2016 – 1337 hours**

A private property crash was reported on Chelsea Drive. The vehicle owners exchanged insurance information and a report was taken.

**November 18, 2016 – 1931 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Possum Run Road where a subject had locked her keys in her vehicle. The office was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

**November 19, 2016 – 0621 hours**

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on Possum Run Road. The driver at-fault, a 17-year old female from Bellbrook struck a parked vehicle and caused extensive damage to both vehicles. The driver was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control. She and her passenger were transported to the hospital. Both vehicles were towed from the scene.

**November 19, 2016 – 0944 hours**

A burglary alarm activation was reported on Clarkston Drive. Upon the officer's arrival the homeowner advised that he had accidentally set off the alarm.
