**November 20, 2016 – 0138 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 62-year old male driver from Centerville was impaired. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving while under the Influence and No License Plate light, and released to a relative.

**November 20, 2016 – 1028 hours**

A resident on Washington Mill Road reported being harassed by a person known to her. Contact was made with the suspect who was ordered to cease all communication with the complainant.

**November 20, 2016 – 1536 hours**

A private property accident was reported in the parking lot of a business on West Franklin Street. Insurance information was exchanged between the vehicle owners and a report taken.

**November 21, 2016 – 1453 hours**

A barking dog was reported on Periwinkle Drive. A caretaker responsible for the dog was issued a verbal warning and explained that any future violations could result in a citation being issued.

**November 22, 2016 – 1139 hours**

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with an attempt to serve an arrest warrant on Upper Hillside Drive. Contact was made with a parent, who advised that the suspect was not home. The parent turned his son over to Sugarcreek Township authorities an hour later.



**November 22, 2016 – 1158 hours**

A reckless driver was reported on East Franklin Street. The vehicle had gone off the roadway several times and also traveled into the oncoming lane of traffic. The vehicle was located on West Franklin Street near Firebird Drive and a stop was made. Investigation revealed that the driver was trying to read a map while driving. The driver was warned for his reckless driving and advised to be cautious when driving.

**November 22, 2016 – 1305 hours**

A juvenile problem was reported on East South Street. A 14-year old female was taken into custody and charged with Menacing and Disorderly Conduct. She was transported to the Greene County Juvenile Detention Center in Xenia.

**November 22, 2016 – 1607 hours**

A resident on Hillrise Circle reported that an unknown subject had used her credit card information and made two purchases totaling over \$800. The bank was notified and the credit card was cancelled. A fraud report was taken.

**November 22, 2016 – 1855 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Mill Pond Drive for a welfare check. The complainant advised that he had been unable to get in touch with his daughter for three days. Upon the officer's arrival, contact was made with the daughter who appeared to be fine. The information was relayed to the complainant.

**November 22, 2016 – 2230 hours**

A theft was reported on West Franklin Street. The complainant advised she believes a relative had stolen \$170.00 in cash from her. Report taken and forwarded to the Juvenile Prosecutor's Office for review.



**November 24, 2016 – 0132 hours**

An officer stopped a vehicle on State Route 725 for a vehicle registration violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old male driver from Dayton did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under a Child Support Suspension.

**November 24, 2016 – 0223 hours**

A vehicle was stopped on South Linda Drive for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 23-year old male driver from Bellbrook was impaired. A drug pipe was located inside the vehicle. The suspect was transported to the hospital due to his extreme state of intoxication, and charged with Driving while under the Influence, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Display of Vehicle Registration.

**November 25, 2016 – 0309 hours**

A vehicle was stopped on State Route 725 after a routine registration check revealed that the 47-year driver from Kettering did not have valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

**November 25, 2016 – 0342 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Barnett Drive on an intrusion alarm activation. The residence checked secure.

**November 25, 2016 – 1340 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Hess Road on the report of a dog running loose in the area. The officer located the dog and returned it to its' owner.
