November 27, 2016 – 0346 hours

While on routine patrol, an officer located an open door at a business on West Franklin Street. With the assistance of a Sugarcreek Township Police officer the building was checked. There were no signs of any criminal activity.

November 27, 2016 – 1005 hours

An officer responded to Lower Hillside Drive on the report of a dog running loose in the area. The owner was located and issued a verbal warning for Dog at Large.

November 27, 2016 – 1503 hours

An officer was dispatched to West Franklin Street for a possible drug violation. Investigation led to a 16-year old male being cited into Greene County Juvenile Court for Drug Abuse, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Possession of Criminal Tools.

November 28, 2016 – 1820 hours

An officer assisted a subject on East Franklin Street who had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

November 29, 2016 – 0943 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle for a Speed violation. Investigation revealed that the 22-year old female driver from Bellbrook did not have a valid driver's license. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Speed.

November 29, 2016 – 1413 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a theft investigation. The suspect who had stolen a computer tablet was located on Shadowood Circle. The stolen property was recovered and returned to the owner, who did not want to pursue criminal charges.



December 1, 2016 – 1528 hours

Officers located two suspicious subjects on West Franklin Street. Investigation revealed that the 37-year old male driver from Conover, Ohio did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension. A 54-year old male passenger from Springfield was wanted on an active warrant from the Clark County Sheriff's Department. He was taken into custody and turned over to a Clark County Sheriff's Deputy.

December 1, 2016 – 1624 hours

Criminal Damaging was reported on Vemco Drive. The complainant advised that his vehicle had been struck with an unknown object causing damage to the driver side mirror. There are no suspects at this time.

December 1, 2016 – 1644 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving fraudulent checks. A detective was assigned to the case.

December 1, 2016 – 2149 hours

An officer located an open shed door behind a business on East Franklin Street. A key holder responded and advised that a new door was installed on the shed that day. The installer had forgotten to secure the door. Nothing was missing from the shed.

December 2, 2016 – 0802 hours

Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of a business on East Franklin Street on the report of a suspicious person. Upon arrival the officers located a 19-year old male from Centerville in his vehicle. The suspect was found to be impaired and taken into custody. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence.
