**December 4, 2016 – 0001 hours**

A resident on Rosecrest Drive reported a criminal mischief complaint. The complainant reported that unknown subject(s) had thrown eggs onto her vehicle and front porch. The report is under investigation.

**December 4, 2016 – 0122 hours**

Officers were dispatched to North Main Street for a welfare check. The complainant advised that her daughter had gotten into a verbal argument with a relative and had left the home on foot. Officers located the female who was highly intoxicated, on West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road. The 22-year old female from Bellbrook was placed under arrest and charged with Public Intoxication. She was transported to the Greene County Jail.

**December 4, 2016 – 0238 hours**

While on routine patrol, an officer located an occupied vehicle in a field off Wilmington-Dayton Road. Contact was made with the occupants, a 17-year old female from Dayton and a 17-year old male from Centerville. The juveniles were found in violation of the City's curfew ordinance. The juveniles were sent on their way home, after their parents were contacted.

**December 5, 2016 – 1343 hours**

A 3-car traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street near North Belleview Drive. Two drivers, a 20-year old male from Bellbrook and a 55-year old male from Xenia were cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Maintain Assured Clear Distance Ahead.

**December 6, 2016 – 1400 hours**

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving a bad check. A detective was assigned to the case. The suspect was located and is in the process of making restitution to the business.



**December 6, 2016 – 1829 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Lynlee Drive where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

**December 7, 2016 – 1158 hours**

A burglary alarm activation was reported on Kensington Drive. Officers responded and upon arrival made contact with the homeowner who advised he had accidentally set off the alarm.

**December 7, 2016 – 2254 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a business on East Franklin Street on the report of a suspicious person inside the building. Contact was made with a female who kept lying to the officers about her identity. The female was finally identified, and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Obstructing Official Business and Falsification. The investigation also revealed that the female was wanted on an active warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail.

**December 8, 2016 – 1053 hours**

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving a bad check. The case was assigned to a detective.

**December 9, 2016 – 2238 hours**

A resident on Nedra Drive reported receiving harassing phone calls from a relative. The relative was contacted and ordered to cease all activity with the complainant.

**December 10, 2016 – 0201 hours**

A routine vehicle registration check of a car parked in the lot of a business on State Route 725 revealed that the driver was wanted on an active warrant from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. The driver refused to speak to the officer and would not give his name or any other identification to the officer. The 25-year old male suspect was taken into custody for Obstructing Official Business and transported to the Greene County Jail. After the suspect's
