December 11, 2016 – 1950 hours

A parking problem was reported on Clearview Drive. The complainant advised that a vehicle was parked so close to his driveway entrance that it restricted him from entering / exiting his driveway. Contact was made with the vehicle owner and the problem was corrected.

December 12, 2016 – 1255 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving a bad check. The case was assigned to a detective.

December 13, 2016 – 1005 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department on Possum Run Road at Fox Run Trail where vehicles had to be cleared from the icy road. A Sugarcreek Township salt truck was dispatched and the roadway was reopened shortly after.

December 13, 2016 – 1840 hours

December 14, 2016 – 1718 hours

A traffic accident was reported on West Franklin Street. The driver at-fault, a 34-year old female from Bellbrook failed to stop for a vehicle turning into the parking lot of a business on West Franklin Street. She was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for ACDA.

December 14, 2016 – 1807 hours

Officers were dispatched to Woodedge Drive on a burglary alarm activation. The residence checked secure.

December 15, 2016- 0155 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on West Franklin Street on the report of an alarm activation. The business was checked without any signs of criminal activity.

December 16, 2016 – 0042 hours

An officer was dispatched to Eckworth Drive on the report of a water main break. The officer stood by until the Bellbrook Service Department arrived.

December 16, 2016 – 0736 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported on West Sudbury Drive. The complainant advised that a white van was driving slowly through the area. An officer located the vehicle and made contact with the driver who was delivering telephone books to the area.

December 16, 2016 – 0843 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Brookwood Drive where a trash truck was backing out of a driveway, striking a moving vehicle. The 31-year old driver at-fault from Huber Heights was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Improper Backing.



December 16, 2016 – 1438 hours

An officer assisted a resident of Upper Hillside Drive who had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

December 16, 2016 – 1946 hours

A resident on Cabernet Way reported that fraudulent charges had been made on his checking account totaling over \$800.00. There are no suspects at this time. The bank cancelled the complainant's debit card, and the complainant was not held responsible for the fraudulent charges.

December 17, 2016 -0007 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Upper Bellbrook Road where a driver lost control of his vehicle, slid off the roadway and ran over a mailbox. The 19-year old male driver from Cedarville was cited into Xenia Municipal Control for Failure to Control.

December 17, 2016 – 0039 hours

An officer assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with traffic control at an accident scene on Conference Road near Ferry Road. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

December 17, 2016 – 0440 hours

Officers were dispatched to Tampico Trail on the report of a disorderly female. Investigation led to the arrest of a 33-year old female for two counts of Assault, 2 counts of Resisting Arrest, Disorderly Conduct, and Criminal Trespassing.



December 17, 2016 – 0959 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported a shoplifter. The store manager advised that a 58-year old male from Bellbrook had come into the store and taken two bottles of vodka without paying for them. The suspect was taken into custody and cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Theft.

December 17, 2016 – 1013 hours

An officer was dispatched to Old English Circle where a male from Celina had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

December 17, 2016 – 1631 hours

An officer assisted a male on North Field Drive who had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer made entry into the vehicle.
