December 18, 2016 – 1822 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Sable Ridge Drive after a routine vehicle registration check revealed that the 27-year old male driver from Middletown did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

December 18, 2016 – 2015 hours

A suspicious person was reported on Upper Hillside Drive. Investigation led to a Criminal Trespass warning issued to a 16-year old male from Kettering.

December 21, 2016 – 0903 hours

A parking problem was reported on Ryder Court. The complainant advised that a vehicle was blocking her driveway. Contact was made with the vehicle owner, who corrected the problem by moving his vehicle.

December 21, 2016 – 1521 hours

An officer was dispatched on the report of an unwanted person on Mill Pond Drive. Investigation led to a 22-year old male from Dayton being Criminally Trespassed from the area.

December 22, 2016 – 1409 hours

Officers were dispatched to Portage Path Drive on the report of a panic alarm activation. Investigation revealed a false alarm.

December 22, 2016 – 1638 hours

Officers assisted the Sugarcreek Township Police Department with a physical fight outside of a business on Wilmington Pike. Several subjects were taken into custody.
