December 25, 2016 – 0944 hours

An officer was dispatched to Eckworth Drive where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to assist and gain entry into the vehicle.

December 25, 2016 – 2004 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for a Speed violation. Further investigation led to drug paraphernalia and marijuana being found inside the vehicle. The 20-year old male driver from Kettering was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for two counts of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 1 count of Drug Abuse, and Speed.

December 26, 2016 – 0152 hours

A vehicle was stopped on Wilmington-Dayton Road for a Loud Muffler violation. Investigation revealed that the 24-year old male driver was impaired. Drugs were located inside the vehicle. The suspect was taken into custody and charged for Operating a Vehicle while under the Influence, Drug Abuse, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

December 27, 2016 – 1057 hours

A resident on Weller Drive reported being harassed by a subject known to her. The suspect was contacted and ordered to cease all communication with the complainant.

December 27, 2016 – 1315 hours

Officers were dispatched to Sable Ridge Drive on a burglary alarm activation. Upon arrival the homeowner advised he had accidentally set off the alarm.

December 27, 2016 – 1323 hours

Officers were dispatched to Mill Pond Drive on a Trespassing complaint. Officers arrested a 22-year old male from Dayton for Criminal Trespassing, who had been issued a warning for the same violation 6 days prior.



December 27, 2016 – 1547 hours

A resident on Vemco Drive reported his daughter was being harassed on social media by a young male subject. The report is under investigation.

December 27, 2016 – 1850 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 18-year old male driver from Washington Courthouse did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and No Rear License Plate Light.

December 28, 2016 – 1612 hours

A female residing on South Main Street reported being harassed by an ex-boyfriend. It was learned that the 38-year old male suspect from Springfield was wanted on two active felony warrants from the Springfield Police Department. Officers were dispatched back to the residence when the suspect arrived at the complainant's home at 1728 hours. The suspect took off running when he observed the officers' arrival but was captured after a short foot pursuit and transported to the Greene County Jail for Resisting Arrest.

December 28, 2016 – 1928 hours

On officer was dispatched to Ryder Court where a vehicle was blocking the complainant's driveway. Contact was made with the vehicle owner who corrected the problem by moving the vehicle.

December 29, 2016 – 1346 hours

A disabled vehicle was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road. The vehicle had run out of fuel. Officers directed traffic until a roadside assistance service arrived with gasoline.



December 29, 2016 – 1537 hours

Officers were dispatched to West Franklin Street for a verbal dispute. The complainant advised that her grandchildren were being disobedient. The juveniles were spoken to and the dispute was settled.

December 30, 2016 – 1730 hours

A resident on Bonniedale Drive reported that an unknown male subject had come up to his door and offered to repair his driveway. The complainant agreed and after the job was completed, allowed the suspect to enter his home while he would get the cash to pay for the job. After paying for the job, the suspect asked to use the complainant's restroom and then left the residence. After the suspect left the victim discovered that roughly \$800 dollars in cash was missing. The victim did not get a name or any other information for the suspect who is described as a white male, 50-60 years old, medium build, driving a white pickup truck.

December 30, 2016 – 1906 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for No Trailer Lights. Investigation revealed that a 37-year old male passenger from Washington Courthouse was wanted on an active warrant from the Ohio State Highway Patrol. The suspect was transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition.
