This is a summary of the City Council work session held on Monday, June 12, 2017 at 6:00 pm.

Police Chief Doherty, Lieutenant Carmin and Sergeant Salyers gave demonstrations on OVI Enforcement and Body Worn Cameras. Staff answered several questions from Council about the implementation and ongoing use of the body worn cameras.

Next, Mr. Schlagheck discussed with Council the future revenue needs. He reviewed the results of the recent survey conducted by the consultant. Several future levy options were reviewed with Council. Legislation will be introduced at the next Council meeting to begin the process of placing a 3 mill, 5 year general fund levy for public safety services on the ballot in November 2017.

Other items discussed included: Admin staffing positions, discussion of request to use Bellbrook land to access other's property on the north side of the Sugar Creek. Mr. Schlagheck also provided an update on the process of becoming a Purple Heart City. Council established the meeting date in August to be the 28th.

Being no further business the work session ended at 8:08 pm.
