January 1, 2017 – 0023 hours

An officer responded to Yellow Springs to help their police department with a large fight in progress. Multiple agencies responded. The officer stood by until no longer needed.

January 1, 2017 – 0054 hours

An officer was dispatched to Eagle Stone Court in Sugarcreek Township where officers needed assistance with a large underage party. The officer remained on scene until no longer needed.

January 1, 2017 – 1056 hours

A disabled vehicle was reported on Little Sugarcreek Road. An officer provided traffic control until the vehicle was pushed off the roadway and into the parking lot of a local business.

January 1, 2017 – 1656 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street for an equipment violation. Investigation revealed that the 26-year old driver from West Carrollton did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension, No Front License Plate, and No Seatbelt.

January 2, 2017 – 1750 hours

An officer stopped a vehicle on West Franklin Street near Little Sugarcreek Road for a Speed violation. Investigation revealed that the 51-year old driver from Centerville did not have a valid driver's license. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension and Speed.

January 2, 2017 – 2036 hours

A domestic dispute was reported on Locus Bend Drive. Investigation revealed that the dispute had been verbal in nature. The involved parties were separated for the evening.



January 3, 2017 – 1330 hours

Officers were dispatched to Plantation Trail on the report of a physical domestic dispute in progress. Investigation revealed that the dispute had only been verbal in nature. No charges filed.

January 4, 2017 – 1128 hours

An officer was dispatched to Moss Oak Trail on the report of a soliciting complaint. The subject was located inside a vehicle with 3 other occupants. Investigation revealed that the 21-year old male suspect from Springfield was wanted on an active warrant from the Clark County Sheriff's Department. He was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail to await extradition. The driver of the vehicle, a 25-year old male from Springfield did not have a valid driver's license. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Driving under Suspension.

January 4, 2017 – 1409 hours

A traffic accident was reported on Mill Pond Drive, where a driver lost control of his vehicle, striking a commercial sign, several bushes, and coming to a stop after crashing into a brick wall. The 30-year old driver at-fault was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Control.

January 5, 2017 – 0709 hours

A disabled vehicle was reported on Wilmington-Dayton Road. An officer provided traffic control until the vehicle was removed from the roadway.

January 5, 2017 – 1316 hours

An officer was dispatched to the parking lot of a business on State Route 725 where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

January 6, 2017 – 1404 hours

A business on West Franklin Street reported receiving four forged checks. The case is under investigation.



January 6, 2017 – 1730 hours

An attempted theft of a car was reported in the parking lot of business on State Route 725. The vehicle owner had started her car to warm up the vehicle, and locked the vehicle. Minutes later she found that the vehicle had been moved several feet, and that the driver's side window was completely busted out. A short time later the Sugarcreek Township Police Department was dispatched to a business across the street where a vehicle that was running with the keys in the ignition, had been stolen. The report has been assigned to a detective.

January 7, 2017 – 1200 hours

A traffic accident with injuries was reported on Wilmington Pike. The driver at-fault, a 71-year old male from Centerville failed to stop for a vehicle that was stopped in front of him. He was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Failure to Maintain Assured Clear Distance Ahead.

January 7, 2017 – 1824 hours

An officer was dispatched to the parking lot of a business on West Franklin Street where a female had locked her keys in her vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.
