**January 8, 2017 – 1200 hours**

A hit/skip accident was reported on North Linda Drive. A legally parked vehicle was sideswiped causing minor damage to the vehicle. The suspect vehicle did not stop or file a report.

**January 8, 2017 – 1242 hours**

A private property accident was reported on West Franklin Street. There was very minor damage to the vehicles involved. The drivers exchanged insurance information.

**January 9, 2017 – 1555 hours**

A resident on South Linda Drive advised that when she came home she found her garage door open. An officer checked the residence and found no signs of criminal activity.

An officer was dispatched to Regent Park Drive where a subject had locked his keys in his vehicle. The officer was able to gain entry into the vehicle.

**January 10, 2017 – 1258 hours**

An officer was dispatched to Big Tree Road on an intrusion alarm activation. Investigation revealed that high winds had caused a door to blow open, setting off the alarm.
